

Deuteronomy 14:1-21 **God's Holy Special People – Laws of Separation**

No Pagan Practices for the Dead [Leviticus 19:28, Deuteronomy 14:1]

1 "You are the children of the LORD your God; you shall not cut yourselves nor shave the front of your head for the dead.

You are Holy People to Yehowah Eloheykm, a Chosen, Special, Above all Other People on Earth

[Exodus 19:5, Deuteronomy 7:6, 12-16, 10:12-15, 14:2, 26:16-19]

2 For you are a holy people to the LORD your God, and the LORD has chosen you to be a people for Himself, a special treasure above all the peoples who are on the face of the earth.

You shall not defile yourselves with detestable food [Leviticus 11:2-47]

3 "You shall not eat any detestable thing.

Animals you may eat

4 These are the animals which you may eat: the ox, the sheep, the goat, 5 the deer, the gazelle, the roe deer, the wild goat, the mountain goat, the antelope, and the mountain sheep. 6 And you may eat every animal with cloven hooves, having the hoof split into two parts, and that chews the cud, among the animals.

Animals you may not eat

7 Nevertheless, of those that chew the cud or have cloven hooves, you shall not eat, such as these: the camel, the hare, and the rock hyrax; for they chew the cud but do not have cloven hooves; they are unclean for you. 8 Also the swine is unclean for you, because it has cloven hooves, yet does not chew the cud; you shall not eat their flesh or touch their dead carcasses.

Fish you may eat

9 "These you may eat of all that are in the waters: you may eat all that have fins and scales.

Water creatures you may not eat

10 And whatever does not have fins and scales you shall not eat; it is unclean for you.

Birds you may eat

11 "All clean birds you may eat.

Birds you may not eat

12 But these you shall not eat: the eagle, the vulture, the buzzard, 13 the red kite, the falcon, and the kite after their kinds; 14 every raven after its kind; 15 the ostrich, the short-eared owl, the seagull, and the hawk after their kinds; 16 the little owl, the screech owl, the white owl, 17 the jackdaw, the carrion vulture, the fisher owl, 18 the stork, the heron after its kind, and the hoopoe and the bat.

Creeping things that fly are forbidden

19 Also every creeping thing that flies is unclean for you; they shall not be eaten.

You may eat all clean birds

20 You may eat all clean birds.

You may not eat anything that dies of itself [Deuteronomy 14:21, Leviticus 7:24, 22:8]

21 "You shall not eat anything that dies of itself; you may give it to the alien who is within your gates, that he may eat it, or you may sell it to a foreigner; for you are a holy people to the LORD your God.

You shall not boil a young goat in its mother's milk. NKJV

Facts Revealed:

No Pagan Practices for the Dead [Leviticus 19:28, 21:5, Deuteronomy 14:1]

- ✧ God is opposed to practices associated with idolatry.
- ✧ As Children of Yehowah Eloheykm (the Lord your God) you must not cut yourself or shave the front of your head for the dead.
 - ◇ That was a practice associated with Baal worship, and practiced by the Philistines and the Moabites. [1 Kings 18:25-28, Jeremiah 47:5, 48:37]
 - ◇ Still it was practiced by Israel as part of their mourning process. [Jeremiah 16:6, 41:5, Micah 1:16]

- ✧ You are holy people to Yehowah Eloheykm (the Lord your God). [Exodus 19:5-6, 22:31]
- ✧ Yehowah has chosen you to be a people for Himself, a special treasure above all the peoples who are on the face of the earth. [Deuteronomy 7:6, 12-16, 10:12-15, 14:2, 26:16-19]

You shall not defile yourselves with detestable food [Leviticus 11:2-47, Deuteronomy 14:3]

- ✧ You shall not eat any detestable thing.

Animals you may eat [Deuteronomy 14:4-6]

- ✧ Every animal with cloven hooves, having the hoof split into two parts, and that chews the cud, among the animals. [Leviticus 11:2-3]
 - ◇ The ox, the sheep, the goat, the deer, the gazelle, the roe deer, the wild goat, the mountain goat, the antelope, and the mountain sheep.

Animals you may not eat [Deuteronomy 14:7-8, Leviticus 11:4-8]

- ✧ Of those that chew the cud or have cloven hooves, you shall not eat:
 - ◇ The camel, the hare, and the rock hyrax; for they chew the cud but do not have cloven hooves; they are unclean for you.
 - ◇ The swine is unclean for you, because it has cloven hooves, yet does not chew the cud.
- ✧ You shall not eat their flesh or touch their dead carcasses.

Fish you may eat [Deuteronomy 14:9, Leviticus 11:9]

- ✧ Of all that are in the waters: you may eat all that have fins and scales.

Water creatures you may not eat [Deuteronomy 14:10, Leviticus 11:10-12]

- ✧ Whatever does not have fins and scales you shall not eat; it is unclean for you.

Birds you may eat [Deuteronomy 14:11]

- ✧ All clean birds you may eat.

Birds you may not eat [Deuteronomy 14:12-19, Leviticus 11:13-19]

- ✧ The eagle, the vulture, the buzzard, the red kite, the falcon, and the kite after their kinds; every raven after its kind; the ostrich, the short-eared owl, the seagull, and the hawk after their kinds; the little owl, the screech owl, the white owl, the jackdaw, the carrion vulture, the fisher owl, the stork, the heron after its kind, and the hoopoe and the bat.

Creeping things that fly are forbidden [Deuteronomy 14:19, Leviticus 11:23]

- ✧ Also every creeping thing that flies is unclean for you; they shall not be eaten.

You may eat all clean birds [Deuteronomy 14:20]

- ✧ You may eat all clean birds.

You may not eat anything that dies of itself [Deuteronomy 14:21, Leviticus 7:24, 22:8]

- ✧ You shall not eat anything that dies of itself.
- ✧ You may give it to the alien who is within your gates, that he may eat it.
- ✧ You may sell it to a foreigner.

- ✧ For you are a holy people to the LORD your God.

- ✧ You shall not boil a young goat in its mother's milk.
- ✧ Searching out the young goat's specific mother for milk to boil the goat in is perversion.
- ✧ This is a practice associated with witchcraft.
