## Deuteronomy 31:9-13 Law Written and Delivered

9 So Moses wrote this law and delivered it to the priests, the sons of Levi, who bore the ark of the covenant of the LORD, and to all the elders of Israel.

10 And Moses commanded them, saying: "At the end of every seven years, at the appointed time in the year of release, at the Feast of Tabernacles, 11 when all Israel comes to appear before the LORD your God in the place which He chooses, you shall read this law before all Israel in their hearing. 12 Gather the people together, men and women and little ones, and the stranger who is within your gates, that they may hear and that they may learn to fear the LORD your God and carefully observe all the words of this law, 13 and that their children, who have not known it, may hear and learn to fear the LORD your God as long as you live in the land which you cross the Jordan to possess." NKJV

## Facts Revealed:

- ☼ The Law was written and delivered to the Priests, Levites who bore the Ark of the Covenant, and to all the Elders of Israel.
  - ♦ All the leaders of Israel had access to the written Law, and thereby no excuse for not knowing its contents, for the purpose of enforcing the Law.
  - ♦ Therefore, later when Jesus made reference to the Law, He used the phrase, "It is Written."
- ❖ At the appointed time of the year of Jubilee, every seven years, when all Israel was required to appear before Yehowah Eloheyk (the Lord your God).
  - ♦ The Law is required to be read to the people so all the people of Israel had a chance to hear the Law and were then obligated to perform the requirements of the Law.
  - ♦ Those who are required to hear the reading of the Law included; all the men, women, little ones, and the stranger who is within your gates.
  - ♦ That they may hear and that they may learn to fear the LORD your God and carefully observe all the words of this law.
  - ♦ That their children, who have not known it, may hear and learn to fear the LORD your God as long as you live in the land which you cross the Jordan to possess.
- ➡ Thus, all future generations of native born Children of Israel as well as all foreigners living among them are required to adhere to the Law as long as you live in the Land of Promise.

  [Deuteronomy 31:9-13]
- ★ This agrees with the requirement that the Law that applies equally to all native Israelites as well as the strangers among them, and it continues throughout all future generations. [Exodus 3:15, 12:14-19, 40-42, 49, 19:9, 20:8-11, 23:12, 31:12-17, Leviticus 3:17, 16:29-34, 17:1-9, 12-16, 18:26-30, 24:22, Numbers 9:14, 15:14-16, 29-31, 19:1-10, 34:15, Deuteronomy 5:12-15, 29, 12:28, 29:14-28, 29, 29:10-13, 31:9-13]
- ★ Moses had written the original Law at Mount Horeb and made it available at the first. [Exodus 24:3-8]
