## Exodus 28:36-38 **Crown – Holiness to Yehowah**

<sup>36</sup> "You shall also make a plate of pure gold and engrave on it, like the engraving of a signet: HOLINESS TO THE LORD. <sup>37</sup> And you shall put it on a blue cord, that it may be on the turban; it shall be on the front of the turban. <sup>38</sup> So it shall be on Aaron's forehead, that Aaron may bear the iniquity of the holy things which the children of Israel hallow in all their holy gifts; and it shall always be on his forehead, that they may be accepted before the LORD. NKJV

## Facts Revealed:

- ★ The Crown is entirely of gold and engraved "HOLINESS TO YEHOWAH," entirely representing the requirement of recognizing the Divinity of God in the service of the Priest.
- **☼** It is attached by a blue cord symbolizing the God of Heaven.
- □ It is on the front of the turban and on the forehead of Aaron the Priest.
- ➡ It represents to the people that Aaron is bearing the iniquity of the holy things that are brought by the Children of Israel to hallow all their holy gifts.
- ☼ It speaks of the Divine Messiah Who becomes the final substitute to take away the punishment we deserve for our iniquity, as we bring a sacrifice substitute to offer for our sins. [Romans 11:27, Hebrews 10:11-14, 1 John 3:5]
- ☼ The Crown must always be on the forehead of the Priest making the priest the mediator between the believing Children of Israel and their God, that they may be accepted before Yehowah.
- The Crown representing deity, symbolizes the Messiah Jesus Who is the divine eternal Mediator between God and man for ever. [1 Timothy 2:5, Hebrews 9:11-15, 12:18-24]
- ☼ We may only be acceptable to God as we depend on the Substitute God has provided in sending Jesus to be our Savior.
- ★ This is done as we believe the promise God gave us that if we believe, we will be saved.
