¹ Then Moses gathered all the congregation of the children of Israel together, and said to them, "These are the words which the LORD has commanded you to do: ² Work shall be done for six days, but the seventh day shall be a holy day for you, a Sabbath of rest to the LORD. Whoever does any work on it shall be put to death. ³ You shall kindle no fire throughout your dwellings on the Sabbath day." NKJV

Facts Revealed:

- Sabbath Day reestablished with the death penalty for disobedience. [Exodus 35:1-3, Genesis 2:2-3, Exodus 16:23-30, 20:8-11, 23:12, 31:12-17, <u>34:21</u>]
- \Rightarrow God is very serious about us receiving one day in seven to rest and remember Him.
- There is a very clear purpose in the Sabbath, as God expressed when He said, "Hallow My Sabbaths, and they will be a sign between Me and you, that you may know that I am the LORD your God." [Ezekiel 20:20]
- ☆ The Sabbath was given as a sign between God and man throughout all generations for the purpose; "That you may know that I am Yehowah Who sanctifies you." [Exodus 31:13]
 - ♦ God wants us to use the seventh day to reflect on the God of Creation and know that it is He Who sets us apart from all the rest of creation to know Him.
