Genesis 1:14-19 Day Four of Creation

¹⁴ Then Elohiym said, "Let there be lights in the firmament of the heavens to divide the day from the night; and let them be for signs and seasons, and for days and years; ¹⁵ and let them be for lights in the firmament of the heavens to give light on the earth"; and it was so. ¹⁶ Then God made two great lights: the greater light to rule the day, and the lesser light to rule the night. He made the stars also. ¹⁷ God set them in the firmament of the heavens to give light on the earth, ¹⁸ and to rule over the day and over the night, and to divide the light from the darkness. And God saw that it was good. ¹⁹ So the evening and the morning were the fourth day. NKJV

The solar system was created the fourth day with many purposes:

- 1. To divide the day from the night giving us time for work and rest.
- 2. For signs as used in every new work that God does through out the history of mankind. Signs are found many times in prophecy; signs of coming events such as in the End Time, described in prophecy both Old & New Testaments "when the sun, moon, and the stars will be darkened" described in Isaiah, Jeremiah, Joel, Matthew, Luke, and Revelation.
- 3. For counting time in days and years.
- 4. To give light on the earth.
- 5. To rule over the day and the night.
- 6. To divide the light from the darkness.
- 7. And again, God wanted us to distinguish between the long time expanse often applied to the word day and a single turn of the earth by using the term "evening and morning" for clarifying and defining the time expanse actually used.
