Hosea 6:1-11 Yahweh is Calling His Impenitent Children to Repentance

A Call to Repentance

- 1 Come, and let us return to Yahweh (the Lord); For He has torn, but He will heal us; He has stricken, but He will bind us up.
- ² After two days He will revive us; On the third day He will raise us up, That we may live in His sight.
- ³ Let us know, Let us pursue the knowledge of Yahweh (the Lord). His going forth is established as the morning; He will come to us like the rain, Like the latter and former rain to the earth.

Impenitence of Israel and Judah

- ⁴ "O Ephraim, what shall I do to you? O Judah, what shall I do to you? For your faithfulness is like a morning cloud, And like the early dew it goes away.
- 5 Therefore I have hewn them by the prophets, I have slain them by the words of My mouth; And your judgments are like light that goes forth.
- ⁶ For I desire mercy and not sacrifice, And the knowledge of Elohiym (God) more than burnt offerings.
- 7 "But like men they transgressed the covenant; There they dealt treacherously with Me.
- 8 Gilead is a city of evildoers And defiled with blood.
- 9 As bands of robbers lie in wait for a man, So the company of priests murder on the way to Shechem; Surely they commit lewdness.
- 10 I have seen a horrible thing in the house of Israel: There is the harlotry of Ephraim; Israel is defiled.
- 11 Also, O Judah, a harvest is appointed for you, When I return the captives of My people. NKJV

Facts Revealed:

A Call to Repentance [Hosea 6:1-3]

- ❖ The call to repentance is to a people Yahweh has punished, and the time to be healed has come.
- ♦ Verse 2 seems to suggest the time of Jesus in the tomb, and His resurrection providing hope for His people to also be raised and live in His sight.
- ♦ Verse 3 calls the people to seek the knowledge of the Lord and understand His ways which has been established from the beginning, with the promised blessings of the Kingdom of righteousness.

Impenitence of Israel and Judah [Hosea 6:4-11]

- ♦ The Northern Kingdom of Israel is called Ephraim, the Southern Kingdom is Judah.
- ♦ Yahweh is grieved that their faithfulness is so fleeting and temporary.
- ♦ Yahweh has faithfully called them back to Himself through the prophets and His warnings of coming judgment.
- ♦ God's people think the way to God is through their ritualistic sacrifices and offerings.
- ♦ Yahweh responded to their religious concept by saying "I desire mercy and not sacrifice,
 the knowledge of Elohiym (God) more than burnt offerings.

- ❖ Through the history of the people, they have dealt treacherously with Yahweh by violating His covenant & laws that was intended to give them life and blessings abundantly.
- ♦ Gilead is a reference to the land of the tribes east of the Jordan River.
- ♦ Yahweh views them all as a city filled with violence and bloodshed which also includes the religious leaders.
- ♦ Yahweh views Israel and Judah as filled with immoral unfaithfulness and defilement leading to judgment, wrath and dispersing of His people world wide..
- ♦ In the face of His Wrath, Yahweh always gives a light of hope for the future.
- ♦ There is an appointed time when Yahweh will give them a harvest, and that time will be when He returns the captives of His people for the Kingdom age still future.
