

## Isaiah 10:20-34 **Future Returning Remnant – Fear Not the Assyrian**

### The future Returning Remnant of Israel

20 And it shall come to pass in that day That the remnant of Israel, And such as have escaped of the house of Jacob, Will never again depend on him who defeated them, But will depend on the Lord, the Holy One of Israel, in truth. 21 The remnant will return, the remnant of Jacob, To the Mighty God.

22 For though your people, O Israel, be as the sand of the sea, A remnant of them will return; The destruction decreed shall overflow with righteousness. 23 For the Lord God of hosts Will make a determined end In the midst of all the land.

### Assyrian invasion shall fail

24 Therefore thus says the Lord God of hosts: "O My people, who dwell in Zion, do not be afraid of the Assyrian. He shall strike you with a rod and lift up his staff against you, in the manner of Egypt.

25 For yet a very little while and the indignation will cease, as will My anger in their destruction." 26 And the Lord of hosts will stir up a scourge for him like the slaughter of Midian at the rock of Oreb; as His rod was on the sea, so will He lift it up in the manner of Egypt.

27 It shall come to pass in that day That his burden will be taken away from your shoulder, And his yoke from your neck, And the yoke will be destroyed because of the anointing oil.

28 He has come to Aiath, He has passed Migron; At Michmash he has attended to his equipment.

29 They have gone along the ridge, They have taken up lodging at Geba. Ramah is afraid, Gibeah of Saul has fled.

30 Lift up your voice, O daughter of Gallim! Cause it to be heard as far as Laish — O poor Anathoth! 31 Madmenah has fled, The inhabitants of Gebim seek refuge.

32 As yet he will remain at Nob that day; He will shake his fist at the mount of the daughter of Zion, The hill of Jerusalem.

33 Behold, the Lord, The Lord of hosts, Will lop off the bough with terror; Those of high stature will be hewn down, And the haughty will be humbled. 34 He will cut down the thickets of the forest with iron, And Lebanon will fall by the Mighty One.

Facts Revealed:

### The plan for a future Returning Remnant of Israel

✧ 20 And it shall come to pass in that day That the remnant of Israel, And such as have escaped of the house of Jacob, Will never again depend on him who defeated them, But will depend on the Lord, the Holy One of Israel, in truth. 21 The remnant will return, the remnant of Jacob, To the Mighty God. [\[Isaiah 10:20-21\]](#)

✧ "In That Day," Refers to a specific time in the future that is appointed by God Himself.

✧ The focus is on those of the northern kingdom of Israel and of the southern kingdom of Judah who have survived to the time spoken of.

✧ The term "never again" speaks of a time which will not change or end.

✧ The identifying concept is that when the Survivors of Israel turn to fully depend on Yahweh Qadowsh Yisrael (the Lord, the holy one of Israel) in truth, it will last forever, for the remnant will turn to El Gibowr (the Mighty God).

- ✧ This will only truly happen during the Kingdom age when Messiah is reigning on the earth from His throne in Jerusalem for a thousand years and on into eternity..
- ✧ Until then, For though your people, O Israel, be as the sand of the sea, A remnant of them will return; The destruction decreed shall overflow with righteousness. [\[Isaiah 10:22\]](#)
  - ✧ All those who do not please Yahweh will be killed during the Great Tribulation where the slain of Yahweh will be many, and at the Judgment Seat of Messiah when all that offends Messiah will be cast into the Lake of Fire leaving only a small remnant to inherit the Kingdom of God and of Christ, a kingdom of righteousness.
  - ✧ A remnant returned from the Babylonian captivity, but were not fully standing for or with Yahweh until the time of Yeshua Messiah (Jesus Christ), after which they were cast out of the Land of Israel until the present time and now those back in the land are mostly secular, certainly not as described above "to the Holy One of Israel."
- ✧ For the Lord God of hosts Will make a determined end In the midst of all the land. [\[Isaiah 10:23\]](#)
  - ✧ The time and the purge are at a time appointed by Yahweh, and what He has determined (purposed) will certainly come to pass just as revealed to us. [\[Isaiah 14:26-27\]](#)
  - ✧ "All the land" refers to the entire earth.

#### Assyrian invasion shall fail – back to the present Assyrian invasion

- ✧ Adoney Yahweh Tsebavta (Lord God of Hosts) gave His people dwelling in Zion encouragement as they face the Assyrian forces that are surrounding Jerusalem, by informing them that the Assyrians will strike them with a rod like the Egyptians did when they enslaved the Children of Israel but only as a punishment from God.  
However when Yahweh is satisfied with the punishment inflicted, He will turn the scourge against the Assyrians like He did to Midian at the rock of Oreb, and the parting of the Red Sea killing the Egyptians.  
Then the burden and yoke of the Assyrians will be removed from Judah because they are anointed as the people of God. [\[Isaiah 10:24-27\]](#)
- ✧ The Assyrians have come to Aiath, passed Migron, at Michmash he attended to his equipment. They went along the ridge and took up lodging at Geba.  
Ramah is afraid and Gibeah of Saul has fled. [\[Isaiah 10:28-29\]](#)
- ✧ It is time for the people of Gallim to lift up their voices so loud that they may be heard as far as Laish. Lament for Anathoth (the city of the Priests, home town of Jeremiah the prophet) Madmenah has already fled, the inhabitants of Gebim seek refuge. [\[Isaiah 10:30-31\]](#)
- ✧ The Assyrians will remain at Nob that day and will shake their fist at the people of Zion the hill of Jerusalem. [\[Isaiah 10:32\]](#)
  - ✧ This is a reference to the Assyrian Rabshakeh and Sennacherib who mocked Yahweh in his letter to Hezekiah. [\[2 Kings 18:1-37, 19:1-37\]](#)
- ✧ Yahweh, Yahweh Tsebavta (the Lord, the Lord of Hosts) will step in and destroy the invaders, sending Sennacherib home humbled, destroying the strength and power of the Assyrians and Lebanon. [\[Isaiah 10:33-34, 2 Kings 18:1-37, 19:1-37\]](#)
