

Isaiah 19:1-25 **Proclamation Against Egypt**

¹ The burden against Egypt.

Behold, the Lord rides on a swift cloud, And will come into Egypt; The idols of Egypt will totter at His presence, And the heart of Egypt will melt in its midst.

² "I will set Egyptians against Egyptians; Everyone will fight against his brother, And everyone against his neighbor, City against city, kingdom against kingdom.

³ The spirit of Egypt will fail in its midst; I will destroy their counsel, And they will consult the idols and the charmers, The mediums and the sorcerers. ⁴ And the Egyptians I will give Into the hand of a cruel master, And a fierce king will rule over them," Says the Lord, the Lord of hosts.

⁵ The waters will fail from the sea, And the river will be wasted and dried up. ⁶ The rivers will turn foul; The brooks of defense will be emptied and dried up; The reeds and rushes will wither. ⁷ The papyrus reeds by the River, by the mouth of the River, And everything sown by the River, Will wither, be driven away, and be no more.

⁸ The fishermen also will mourn; All those will lament who cast hooks into the River, And they will languish who spread nets on the waters.

⁹ Moreover those who work in fine flax And those who weave fine fabric will be ashamed; ¹⁰ And its foundations will be broken. All who make wages will be troubled of soul.

¹¹ Surely the princes of Zoan are fools; Pharaoh's wise counselors give foolish counsel. How do you say to Pharaoh, "I am the son of the wise, The son of ancient kings?"

¹² Where are they? Where are your wise men? Let them tell you now, And let them know what the Lord of hosts has purposed against Egypt.

¹³ The princes of Zoan have become fools; The princes of Noph are deceived; They have also deluded Egypt, Those who are the mainstay of its tribes.

¹⁴ The Lord has mingled a perverse spirit in her midst; And they have caused Egypt to err in all her work, As a drunken man staggers in his vomit. ¹⁵ Neither will there be any work for Egypt, Which the head or tail, Palm branch or bulrush, may do.

¹⁶ In that day Egypt will be like women, and will be afraid and fear because of the waving of the hand of the Lord of hosts, which He waves over it.

¹⁷ And the land of Judah will be a terror to Egypt; everyone who makes mention of it will be afraid in himself, because of the counsel of the Lord of hosts which He has determined against it.

Egypt, Assyria, and Israel Blessed

¹⁸ In that day five cities in the land of Egypt will speak the language of Canaan and swear by the Lord of hosts; one will be called the City of Destruction.

¹⁹ In that day there will be an altar to the Lord in the midst of the land of Egypt, and a pillar to the Lord at its border. ²⁰ And it will be for a sign and for a witness to the Lord of hosts in the land of Egypt; for they will cry to the Lord because of the oppressors, and He will send them a Savior and a Mighty One, and He will deliver them.

²¹ Then the Lord will be known to Egypt, and the Egyptians will know the Lord in that day, and will make sacrifice and offering; yes, they will make a vow to the Lord and perform it.

22 And the Lord will strike Egypt, He will strike and heal it; they will return to the Lord, and He will be entreated by them and heal them.

23 In that day there will be a highway from Egypt to Assyria, and the Assyrian will come into Egypt and the Egyptian into Assyria, and the Egyptians will serve with the Assyrians.

24 In that day Israel will be one of three with Egypt and Assyria — a blessing in the midst of the land, 25 whom the Lord of hosts shall bless, saying, "Blessed is Egypt My people, and Assyria the work of My hands, and Israel My inheritance."

Facts Revealed:

✧ Behold, the Lord rides on a swift cloud, And will come into Egypt; The idols of Egypt will totter at His presence, And the heart of Egypt will melt in its midst.

"I will set Egyptians against Egyptians; Everyone will fight against his brother, And everyone against his neighbor, City against city, kingdom against kingdom.

✧ The beginning of the fall of Egypt will be when she falls under the rule of the Antichrist at the beginning of the Great Tribulation with the final fall along with the fall of the nations at the time of Judgment and the purge of the earth when all evil is removed.

✧ As Yahweh sets up His Kingdom Egypt is found to be among the nations that fall because of their false gods and witchcraft. [Isaiah 19:5-10]

✧ The waters will fail from the sea, And the river will be wasted and dried up. The rivers will turn foul; The brooks of defense will be emptied and dried up; The reeds and rushes will wither. The papyrus reeds by the River, by the mouth of the River, And everything sown by the River, Will wither, be driven away, and be no more.

The fishermen also will mourn; All those will lament who cast hooks into the River, And they will languish who spread nets on the waters.

Moreover those who work in fine flax And those who weave fine fabric will be ashamed; and its foundations will be broken. All who make wages will be troubled of soul. [Isaiah 17:5-10]

✧ The land of Egypt will become desolate.

✧ Surely the princes of Zoan are fools; Pharaoh's wise counselors give foolish counsel. How do you say to Pharaoh, "I am the son of the wise, The son of ancient kings?"

Where are they? Where are your wise men? Let them tell you now, And **let them know what Yahweh Tsebavta (the Lord of hosts) has purposed against Egypt.**

The princes of Zoan have become fools; The princes of Noph are deceived; They have also deluded Egypt, Those who are the mainstay of its tribes.

The Lord has mingled a perverse spirit in her midst; And they have caused Egypt to err in all her work, As a drunken man staggers in his vomit. Neither will there be any work for Egypt, Which the head or tail, Palm branch or bulrush, may do. [Isaiah 19:11-15]

✧ What Yahweh has **purposed** can not be turned back or restrained by mankind.

✧ In that day Egypt will be like women, and will be afraid and fear because of the waving of the hand of Yahweh Tsebavta (the Lord of hosts), which He waves over it.

And the land of Judah will be a terror to Egypt; everyone who makes mention of it will be

afraid in himself, **because of the counsel of Yahweh Tsebvta (the Lord of hosts) which He has determined against it.** [Isaiah 19:16-17]

- ✧ When Messiah takes control and begins to reign in Zion, the world will be humbled and know the fear of the Lord Who has become both judge and ruler.
- ✧ In That Day indicates that the judgment of evil and the Kingdom age when Christ will reign as King of kings and Lord of lords is all known as the Day of Yahweh (The Day of The Lord).

Egypt, Assyria, and Israel Blessed – Kingdom Age

- ✧ In that day five cities in the land of Egypt will speak the language of Canaan and swear by the Lord of hosts; one will be called the City of Destruction. [Isaiah 19:18]
- ✧ When Egypt has become desolate, the city will be called the City of Destruction.
- ✧ In that day there will be an altar to the Lord in the midst of the land of Egypt, and a pillar to the Lord at its border. And it will be for a sign and for a witness to the Lord of hosts in the land of Egypt; for they will cry to the Lord because of the oppressors, and He will send them a Savior and a Mighty One, and He will deliver them. [Isaiah 19:19-20]
- ✧ When Messiah is Lord of lords, and King of kings, the Egyptians will certainly know Him and will build an altar to Him in the midst of the land, they will also put a pillar to Him on the border with Israel. These will serve as a sign and memorial to Yahweh.
- ✧ When Egypt is suffering oppression under the rule of the Antichrist they will cry to Yahweh Whom they know to be the One sending the plagues of the Great Tribulation and He will send Messiah at the appointed time, He will cast the Antichrist into the Lake of Fire and deliver the remnant of Egypt as He sets up His Kingdom.
- ✧ Then the Lord will be known to Egypt, and the Egyptians will know the Lord in that day, and will make sacrifice and offering; yes, they will make a vow to the Lord and perform it. And the Lord will strike Egypt, He will strike and heal it; they will return to Yahweh (the Lord), and He will be entreated by them and heal them. [Isaiah 19:21-22]
- ✧ What a change in the time of the Day of Yahweh. All will know Him and turn to Him.
- ✧ In that day there will be a highway from Egypt to Assyria, and the Assyrian will come into Egypt and the Egyptian into Assyria, and the Egyptians will serve with the Assyrians. [Isaiah 19:23]
- ✧ In that day Israel will be one of three with Egypt and Assyria — a blessing in the midst of the land, whom the Lord of hosts shall bless, saying, "**Blessed is Egypt My people, and Assyria the work of My hands, and Israel My inheritance.**" [Isaiah 19:24-25]
- ✧ Egypt and Israel are known today as they were known in Bible times.
- ✧ Assyria is today known as Iraq.
- ✧ What a blessed day that will be when such long time enemies are united together in the love and worship of Yahweh Tsebvta, because Jesus is here as King of kings and Lord of lords over all the earth.
