 - ♦ The people who follow their ungodliness will also be subject to the same punishment.
- ➡ Hear, you who are afar off, what I have done; And you who are near, acknowledge My might." [Isaiah 33:13]
 - ♦ The message is a warning to everyone calling them to consider the mighty judgment of God, their latter end, and their need to repent while there is still time.
- ☆ The sinners in Zion are afraid; Fearfulness has seized the hypocrites: "Who among us shall dwell with the devouring fire? Who among us shall dwell with everlasting burnings?" [Isaiah 33:14]
 - ♦ The prospect of facing the Wrath of God is a fearful thing for the guilty who know the fiery destiny awaiting them in Hell and the Eternal Lake of Fire where they cannot die and the fire cannot be quenched. [Isaiah 66:24, Mark 9:44, 46, 48]
 - ♦ Like Paul said, "It is a fearful thing to fall into the hands of the living God." [Hebrews 10:31]
- ➡ He who walks righteously and speaks uprightly, He who despises the gain of oppressions, Who gestures with his hands, refusing bribes, Who stops his ears from hearing of bloodshed, And shuts his eyes from seeing evil:
