Isaiah 4:1 Unequal Gender Count entering the Kingdom Age

And in that day seven women shall take hold of one man, saying, "We will eat our own food and wear our own apparel; Only let us be called by your name, To take away our reproach." NKJV

Commentary:

After the purge of evil at the Judgment Seat of Christ is over there will be only one man to seven women surviving to enter into the Thousand Year Reign of Christ as mortals. This is not meant for the pleasure of the men, but is a rebuke against the carelessness in the heart that resists the call to righteousness.

The unequal remnant is because the men had rebelled in arrogant disobedience, while the women had accepted the Lord and responded in humble obedience. Thus, the men were purged away and the women were left without husbands. Hypocrisy abounds among Church attendees that needs to be earnestly dealt with, it is one thing God will not accept.

The reproach is that of being widows with no hope of finding fulfillment in marriage, and the shame of realizing that the husband was found unworthy of the kingdom. A look at the average congregation will quickly confirm the unequal attendance with a shortage of men.

Many in the churches are not serious about their relationship with God. They do not allow that relationship to influence their everyday activities, speech, work, recreation, priorities, nor their responsibility to their spouse and children. This is evident when we look at the rate of divorce and child abuse today experienced in the church as well as in secular society. God knows the truth, and He knows the very heart and mind of every person. Therefore, the purge will be accurate and sure.
