Message to the Zedekiah

- 1 The word which came to Jeremiah from the Lord when King Zedekiah sent to him Pashhur the son of Melchiah, and Zephaniah the son of Maaseiah, the priest, saying,
- ² "Please inquire of the Lord for us, for Nebuchadnezzar king of Babylon makes war against us. Perhaps the Lord will deal with us according to all His wonderful works, that the king may go away from us."
- 3 Then Jeremiah said to them, "Thus you shall say to Zedekiah,
- ⁴ 'Thus says the Lord God of Israel: "Behold, I will turn back the weapons of war that are in your hands, with which you fight against the king of Babylon and the Chaldeans who besiege you outside the walls; and I will assemble them in the midst of this city.
- ⁵ I Myself will fight against you with an outstretched hand and with a strong arm, even in anger and fury and great wrath.
- 6 I will strike the inhabitants of this city, both man and beast; they shall die of a great pestilence.
- ⁷ And afterward," says the Lord, "I will deliver Zedekiah king of Judah, his servants and the people, and such as are left in this city from the pestilence and the sword and the famine, into the hand of Nebuchadnezzar king of Babylon, into the hand of their enemies, and into the hand of those who seek their life; and he shall strike them with the edge of the sword. He shall not spare them, or have pity or mercy."

Message to the People

- 8 "Now you shall say to this people, 'Thus says the Lord: "Behold, I set before you the way of life and the way of death.
- 9 He who remains in this city shall die by the sword, by famine, and by pestilence; but he who goes out and defects to the Chaldeans who besiege you, he shall live, and his life shall be as a prize to him.
- 10 For I have set My face against this city for adversity and not for good," says the Lord. "It shall be given into the hand of the king of Babylon, and he shall burn it with fire."

Message to the House of David

 - ♦ Now when they see the Babylonian army with their own eyes they turn to Jeremiah to intercede for them.
 - ♦ This is exactly the thing the people will do when the end time prophesies begin to be fulfilled before their eyes. Why do they not believe the warnings when there is time to repent and be delivered?
- ★ Then Jeremiah said to them, "Thus you shall say to Zedekiah,"

'Thus says Yahweh Elohey Yisrael (the Lord God of Israel): "Behold, I will turn back the weapons of war that are in your hands, with which you fight against the king of Babylon and the Chaldeans who besiege you outside the walls; and I will assemble them in the midst of this city.

I Myself will fight against you with an outstretched hand and with a strong arm, even in anger and fury and great wrath.

I will strike the inhabitants of this city, both man and beast; they shall die of a great pestilence.

And afterward," says Yahweh (the Lord), "I will deliver Zedekiah king of Judah, his servants and the people, and such as are left in this city from the pestilence and the sword and the famine, into the hand of Nebuchadnezzar king of Babylon, into the hand of their enemies, and into the hand of those who seek their life; and he shall strike them with the edge of the sword. He shall not spare them, or have pity or mercy." [Jeremiah 21:3-7]

- ♦ The message from Yahweh is that He Himself will fight against the people of Jerusalem in great anger, fury, and wrath and will help the Babylonians destroy Judah and Jerusalem.
- ♦ Those who go out to the king of Babylon will escape the famine and pestilence of the siege but will be slain without pity or mercy.

Message to the People

☼ "Now you shall say to this people, 'Thus says the Lord: "Behold, I set before you the way of life and the way of death.

He who remains in this city shall die by the sword, by famine, and by pestilence; but he who goes out and defects to the Chaldeans who besiege you, he shall live, and his life shall be as a prize to him.

For I have set My face against this city for adversity and not for good," says the Lord. "It shall be given into the hand of the king of Babylon, and he shall burn it with fire." [Jeremiah 21:8-10]

- ♦ Yahweh offers life or death to the people.
- ♦ Life if they defect to the king of Babylon.
- ♦ Death if they remain in the city.
- ♦ Death by sword, famine, or pestilence.
- ♦ Yahweh has set His face against Jerusalem for adversity and not for good, it will fall to the Babylonians.

Message to the House of David

O house of David! Thus says the Lord:

"Execute judgment in the morning; And deliver him who is plundered Out of the hand of the oppressor, Lest My fury go forth like fire And burn so that no one can quench it, Because of the evil of your doings.
