Restoration of Israel and Judah

- 1 The word that came to Jeremiah from the Lord, saying,
- ² "Thus speaks the Lord God of Israel, saying: 'Write in a book for yourself all the words that I have spoken to you.
- ³ For behold, the days are coming,' says the Lord, 'that I will bring back from captivity My people Israel and Judah,' says the Lord. 'And I will cause them to return to the land that I gave to their fathers, and they shall possess it.'"
- ⁴ Now these are the words that the Lord spoke concerning Israel and Judah.
- 5 "For thus says the Lord:
- 'We have heard a voice of trembling, Of fear, and not of peace.
- 6 Ask now, and see, Whether a man is ever in labor with child? So why do I see every man with his hands on his loins Like a woman in labor, And all faces turned pale?
- ⁷ Alas! For that day is great, So that none is like it; And it is the time of Jacob's trouble, But he shall be saved out of it.
- 8 'For it shall come to pass in that day, 'Says the Lord of hosts, 'That I will break his yoke from your neck, And will burst your bonds; Foreigners shall no more enslave them.
- 9 But they shall serve the Lord their God, And David their king, Whom I will raise up for them.
- ¹⁰ 'Therefore do not fear, O My servant Jacob,' says the Lord, 'Nor be dismayed, O Israel; For behold, I will save you from afar, And your seed from the land of their captivity. Jacob shall return, have rest and be quiet, And no one shall make him afraid.
- 11 For I am with you,' says the Lord, 'to save you; Though I make a full end of all nations where I have scattered you, Yet I will not make a complete end of you. But I will correct you in justice, And will not let you go altogether unpunished.'

Incurable Sin & Iniquity

12 "For thus says the Lord:

'Your affliction is incurable, Your wound is severe.

- 13 There is no one to plead your cause, That you may be bound up; You have no healing medicines.
- 14 All your lovers have forgotten you; They do not seek you; For I have wounded you with the wound of an enemy, With the chastisement of a cruel one, For the multitude of your iniquities, Because your sins have increased.
- 15 Why do you cry about your affliction? Your sorrow is incurable. Because of the multitude of your iniquities, Because your sins have increased, I have done these things to you.

Judgment of the oppressors

- ¹⁶ 'Therefore all those who devour you shall be devoured; And all your adversaries, every one of them, shall go into captivity; Those who plunder you shall become plunder, And all who prey upon you I will make a prey.
- 17 For I will restore health to you And heal you of your wounds,' says the Lord, 'Because they called you an outcast saying: "This is Zion; No one seeks her."

Promised Restoration of Israel and Judah to the Kingdom

- 18 "Thus says the Lord: 'Behold, I will bring back the captivity of Jacob's tents, And have mercy on his dwelling places; The city shall be built upon its own mound, And the palace shall remain according to its own plan.
- 19 Then out of them shall proceed thanksgiving And the voice of those who make merry; I will multiply them, and they shall not diminish; I will also glorify them, and they shall not be small.
 20 Their children also shall be as before, And their congregation shall be established before Me; And I will punish all who oppress them.
- 21 Their nobles shall be from among them, And their governor shall come from their midst; Then I will cause him to draw near, And he shall approach Me; For who is this who pledged his heart to approach Me?' says the Lord.

Hope for Israel's Future

- ★ The word that came to Jeremiah from Yahweh (the Lord), saying,
 - "Thus speaks Yahweh Elohey Yisrael (the Lord God of Israel), saying: 'Write in a book for yourself all the words that I have spoken to you.
 - For behold, **the days are coming**,' says Yahweh (the Lord), 'that I will bring back from captivity My people **Israel and Judah**,' says Yahweh (the Lord),. 'And I will cause them to return to the land that I gave to their fathers, and they shall possess it.'" [Jeremiah 30:1-3]
 - ♦ Yahweh has a future plan for the restoration of all of Israel, both the northern kingdom of Israel and the southern kingdom of Judah together as one nation.
 - ♦ The plan is to be recorded in a book for future reference.
- Now these are the words that Yahweh (the Lord), spoke concerning Israel and Judah. "For thus says Yahweh (the Lord),:
 - 'We have heard a voice of trembling, Of fear, and not of peace.
 - Ask now, and see, Whether a man is ever in labor with child? So why do I see every man with his hands on his loins Like a woman in labor, And all faces turned pale?
 - Alas! For that day is great, So that **none is like it**; And it is the **time of Jacob's trouble**, But he shall be saved out of it. [Jeremiah 30:4-7]
 - ♦ The restoration will follow a time of great anguish like the birth pangs of a woman in labor of child birth referred to as the time of Jacob's Trouble. [Jeremiah 30:7]
 - ♦ It will be a time like no other time before or after known as the Great Tribulation. [Daniel 12:1, Matthew 24:21, Mark 13:19, Luke 21:22-23, 25-26]
 - ♦ A time of trembling and fear, not of peace.
 - ♦ Jacob (Israel) will be saved out of it. [Jeremiah 30:7, Daniel 12:1]

them.But they shall serve Yahweh Eloheyhm (the Lord their God), And David their king, Whom I will raise up for them. [Jeremiah 30:8-9]

- **♦ That Day** is a reference to the time of the **Kingdom** age after the Great Tribulation.
- ♦ Satan's yoke of sin will forever be broken from the necks of mankind.
- ❖ Israel will be restored as the leading nation of the world with Yahweh reigning as King of kings and Lord of lords in perfect righteousness government from Zion.
- ♦ Foreigners (Gentiles) will no longer enslave the Jews or oppress them, they will serve Yahweh Elohevhm.
- ♦ David will be king (prince) over Israel. [Jeremiah 30:9, Ezekiel 34:23-24, 37:21-28]
- - For I am with you,' says Yahweh (the Lord),, 'to save you; Though I make a full end of all nations where I have scattered you, Yet I will not make a complete end of you. But I will correct you in justice, And will not let you go altogether unpunished.' [Jeremiah 30:10-11]
 - ❖ Israel and the Jews are encouraged with the revelation of a glorious future in the Kingdom of God and of Messiah.
 - ♦ All Israel will be brought back to the Promised Land in security and quiet.
 - ♦ They will be brought back from all the nations where they have been scattered.
 - ♦ Yahweh will make a full end of all the nations where the Children of Israel were scattered, yet He will not make a complete end of the Israelites.
 - ♦ Because of their continual sins Yahweh could not let Israel go altogether unpunished, but was compelled to deal with their iniquities in true justice.

Incurable Sin & Iniquity

♥ "For thus says Yahweh (the Lord),:

'Your affliction is incurable, Your wound is severe.

There is no one to plead your cause, That you may be bound up; You have no healing medicines. All your lovers have forgotten you; They do not seek you; For I have wounded you with the wound of an enemy, With the chastisement of a cruel one, For the multitude of your iniquities, Because your sins have increased.

Why do you cry about your affliction? Your sorrow is incurable. Because of the multitude of your iniquities, Because your sins have increased, I have done these things to you. [Jeremiah 30:12-15]

- ♦ The punishment Israel is suffering is brought upon them because of their multitude of sins and iniquities.
- ♦ They cannot respond to Yahweh's call for repentance because of their addiction to their sins making them incurable.
- ♦ Crying about their affliction is useless because it does not result in repentance.
 Judgment of the oppressors

For I will restore health to you And heal you of your wounds,' says Yahweh (the Lord),, 'Because they called you an outcast saying: "This is Zion; No one seeks her." [Jeremiah 30:16-17]

- → Judgment will come to all who oppress Israel because of their own pride and arrogance in glorying in their power over the Israelites.
- ♦ Their power over Israel was enabled by Yahweh when He delivered Israel into the hands of their oppressors as punishment for the sins of Israel.

- ♦ The oppressors became prideful against Israel by what seemed their power over the people Yahweh was punishing.
- ♦ They ridiculed Israel calling them outcasts, and Zion saying no one seeks her.
- ♦ Yahweh assured Israel that He will heal her wounds and restore her health.

[Genesis 17:3-9, Exodus 6:7, 29:45-46, Leviticus 26:12, 44-45, Jeremiah 7:23, 11:4, 24:7, 30:22, 31:1, 33, 31:33, Ezekiel 11:20, 14:11, 36:28, 37:23, Zechariah 8:8, 13:9, 2 Corinthians 6:16, Hebrews 8:10, Revelation 21:3]
- ♦ Restoration of Israel in mercy.
- ♦ Restoration of Jerusalem and Zion.
- ❖ Resulting in thanksgiving, gladness, multiplying, and glory.
- ♦ Restoration of Righteous government.
- ♦ Those who oppressed them will be punished.

Yahweh will accomplish all He has purposed and declared
