

Jeremiah 31:1-14 **All Israel will be saved – The Remnant that enters the Kingdom**

Kingdom Restoration of all Israel

1 "At the same time," says the Lord, "I will be the God of all the families of Israel, and they shall be My people."

2 Thus says the Lord:

"The people who survived the sword found grace in the wilderness — Israel, when I went to give him rest."

3 The Lord has appeared of old to me, saying: "Yes, I have loved you with an everlasting love; Therefore with lovingkindness I have drawn you.

4 Again I will build you, and you shall be rebuilt, O virgin of Israel! You shall again be adorned with your tambourines, And shall go forth in the dances of those who rejoice.

5 You shall yet plant vines on the mountains of Samaria; The planters shall plant and eat them as ordinary food.

6 For there shall be a day When the watchmen will cry on Mount Ephraim, 'Arise, and let us go up to Zion, To the Lord our God.'"

Returning Remnant

7 For thus says the Lord:

"Sing with gladness for Jacob, And shout among the chief of the nations; Proclaim, give praise, and say, 'O Lord, save Your people, The remnant of Israel!'

8 Behold, I will bring them from the North Country, And gather them from the ends of the earth, among them the blind and the lame, the woman with child and the one who labors with child, together; A great throng shall return there.

9 They shall come with weeping, and with supplications I will lead them. I will cause them to walk by the rivers of waters, In a straight way in which they shall not stumble; For I am a Father to Israel, And Ephraim is My firstborn.

10 "Hear the word of the Lord, O nations, and declare it in the isles afar off, and say, 'He who scattered Israel will gather him, and keep him as a shepherd does his flock.'

11 For the Lord has redeemed Jacob, and ransomed him from the hand of one stronger than he.

12 Therefore they shall come and sing in the height of Zion, Streaming to the goodness of the Lord — For wheat and new wine and oil, For the young of the flock and the herd; Their souls shall be like a well-watered garden, And they shall sorrow no more at all.

13 "Then shall the virgin rejoice in the dance, And the young men and the old, together; For I will turn their mourning to joy, Will comfort them, And make them rejoice rather than sorrow.

14 I will satiate the soul of the priests with abundance, and My people shall be satisfied with My goodness, says the Lord."

Facts Revealed:

✧ **"At the same time,"** says Yahweh (the Lord), "I will be Elohiym (the God) of all the families of Israel, and they shall be My people."

Thus says Yahweh (the Lord):

"The people who survived the sword found grace in the wilderness — Israel, when I went to give him rest."

Yahweh (the Lord) has appeared of old to me, saying: "Yes, I have loved you with an

everlasting love; Therefore with lovingkindness I have drawn you.

Again I will build you, and you shall be rebuilt, O virgin of Israel! You shall again be adorned with your tambourines, And shall go forth in the dances of those who rejoice.

You shall yet plant vines on the mountains of Samaria; The planters shall plant and eat them as ordinary food.

For there shall be a day When the watchmen will cry on Mount Ephraim, '**Arise, and let us go up to Zion, To Yahweh Eloheynu (the Lord our God).**'" [Jeremiah 31:1-6]

✧ The last chapter dealt with the Restoration of Israel and Judah at the time of the Kingdom.

✧ The time will be when Yahweh judges and removes all evil, and restores the remnant of Judah and Israel to His Kingdom where He reigns in Zion over the entire world.

✧ This will be the time Yahweh has yearned for from the very beginning:

Yahweh will be their God and Israel will be His People. [Genesis 17:3-9, Exodus 6:7, 29:45-46, Leviticus 26:12, 44-45, Jeremiah 7:23, 11:4, 24:7, 30:22, 31:1, 33, 31:33, Ezekiel 11:20, 14:11, 36:28, 37:23, Zechariah 8:8, 13:9, 2 Corinthians 6:16, Hebrews 8:10, Revelation 21:3]

✧ The promise is to the people who survive to the time of the Kingdom.

✧ Verse 3 expresses the love of Yahweh for His people Israel.

✧ The promise is to rebuild Israel in the Promised Land for their good and glory.

✧ Verse 6 clearly identifies the day as the time when Yahweh will be visibly present in Zion where the people can go to Him directly and see Him.

Returning Remnant

✧ For thus says Yahweh (the Lord):

"Sing with gladness for Jacob, And shout among the chief of the nations; Proclaim, give praise, and say, 'O Yahweh (Lord), save Your people, **The remnant of Israel!**'

Behold, I will bring them from the North Country, And gather them from the ends of the earth, among them the blind and the lame, the woman with child and the one who labors with child, together; A great throng shall return there.

They shall come with weeping, and with supplications I will lead them. I will cause them to walk by the rivers of waters, In a straight way in which they shall not stumble; For I am a Father to Israel, And Ephraim is My firstborn. [Jeremiah 31:7-9]

✧ After the purge of all evil from the earth, still the **remnant of Israel** will make up a great throng of people brought back to the Land of Israel from all the nations where they were scattered.

✧ All Israel alive at that time to enter the Kingdom will be saved. [Romans 11:25-27]

✧ Included will be the blind, the lame, the women with child, and the women in labor of childbirth.

✧ They will come with weeping and supplications for those loved ones who were lost in the purge because the slain of the Lord will be many.

✧ Yahweh will lead them in righteousness where they will not stumble.

✧ Through out the Old covenant, after the kingdom was divided, the Southern kingdom is referred to as Judah, and the northern kingdom is often referred to as Ephraim, and here Yahweh calls Ephraim His firstborn.

✧ "Hear the word of Yahweh (the Lord), O nations, and declare it in the isles afar off, and say, 'He who scattered Israel will gather him, and keep him as a shepherd does his flock.'

For Yahweh (the Lord) has redeemed Jacob, and ransomed him from the hand of one stronger than he. [Jeremiah 31:10-11]

✧ The Regathering of Israel will be a testimony to the nations of the earth that Yahweh is a God of His Word, because they will realize that all Yahweh has promised concerning Israel He has fulfilled openly in the sight of all nations.

✧ Therefore they shall come and sing in the height of Zion, Streaming to the goodness of Yahweh (the Lord) — For wheat and new wine and oil, For the young of the flock and the herd; Their souls shall be like a well-watered garden, And they shall sorrow no more at all. "Then shall the virgin rejoice in the dance, And the young men and the old, together; For I will turn their mourning to joy, Will comfort them, And make them rejoice rather than sorrow.

I will satiate the soul of the priests with abundance, and My people shall be satisfied with My goodness, says Yahweh (the Lord)." [\[Jeremiah 31:12-14\]](#)

✧ The return to Zion of all Israel will be a time of joy and rejoicing.

✧ The Kingdom age will be a time of great abundance from Yahweh.

✧ All sorrow will be ended and all will overflow with peace and joy of the Lord.
