## Jeremiah 49:34-39 Fall and Restoration of Elam declared by Yahweh

## Judgment on Elam

- 34 The word of Yahweh (the Lord) that came to Jeremiah the prophet against Elam, in the beginning of the reign of Zedekiah king of Judah, saying,
- 35 "Thus says Yahweh Tsebaovt (the Lord of hosts):
- 'Behold, I will break the bow of Elam, The foremost of their might.
- 36 Against Elam I will bring the four winds From the four quarters of heaven, And scatter them toward all those winds; There shall be no nations where the outcasts of Elam will not go.
- 37 For I will cause Elam to be dismayed before their enemies And before those who seek their life. I will bring disaster upon them, My fierce anger,' says Yahweh (the Lord);
- 'And I will send the sword after them Until I have consumed them.
- <sup>38</sup> I will set My throne in Elam, And will destroy from there the king and the princes,' says Yahweh (the Lord).
- <sup>39</sup> 'But it shall come to pass in the latter days: I will bring back the captives of Elam,' says Yahweh (the Lord)."

- ♦ Elam was the first born of the sons of Shem. [Genesis 10:22]
- ♦ Elam was numbered among the kings of the East. [Genesis 10:22-30]
- ❖ Zedekiah was the last king of Judah before the fall of Jerusalem to the Babylonians.
- ♦ The king of Babylon laid siege against Jerusalem from the ninth to the eleventh and last year of Zedekiah. [2 Kings 25:1-3, Jeremiah 39:1-2, 52:1-11]
- ♦ The fall of Elam was declared by Yahweh at the beginning of the reign of Zedekiah.
- ♦ The people of Elam were scattered through out the kingdoms of the earth.
- ♦ The restoration of Elam is promised in the latter days.
