Lamentation for Judgment against Disobedient People

- Oh, that my head were waters, And my eyes a fountain of tears, That I might weep day and night For the slain of the daughter of my people!
- ² Oh, that I had in the wilderness A lodging place for travelers; That I might leave my people, And go from them! For they are all adulterers, An assembly of treacherous men.
- ³ "And like their bow they have bent their tongues for lies. They are not valiant for the truth on the earth. For they proceed from evil to evil, And they do not know Me," says the Lord.
- 4 "Everyone take heed to his neighbor, And do not trust any brother; For every brother will utterly supplant, And every neighbor will walk with slanderers.
- ⁵ Everyone will deceive his neighbor, And will not speak the truth; They have taught their tongue to speak lies; They weary themselves to commit iniquity.
- 6 Your dwelling place is in the midst of deceit; Through deceit they refuse to know Me," says the Lord.

 - but they have walked according to the dictates of their own hearts and after the Baals, which their fathers taught them,"
 - therefore thus says Yahweh Tsebavta Elohey Yisrael (the Lord of hosts, the God of Israel): "Behold, I will feed them, this people, with wormwood, and give them water of gall to drink. I will scatter them also among the Gentiles, whom neither they nor their fathers have known. And I will send a sword after them until I have consumed them." [Jeremiah 9:13-16]
 - ♦ The answer from Yahweh is "Because they have forsaken My law which I set before them, and they have not obeyed My voice or walked according to it.

- ♦ The people have walked according to the dictates of their own hearts and idolatry.
- ♦ The punishment for their sins is totally justified.
- ♦ They will be scattered among the Gentiles where they will be killed.
- ♦ This has certainly been done as spoken by all the attempts to exterminate the Jews in lands of their dispersion since they were cast out of their Promised Land.

- ♦ Lament because death comes through the windows, enters the palaces, and kills off the children to leave the city desolate without inhabitant.
- ❖ Even the carcasses of men will fall as refuse on the open field and no one will gather them for burial.

Glory only in Yahweh
