

John 4:43-54 **Nobleman's son in Capernaum healed from Cana**

Samaria to Galilee

43 Now after the two days He departed from there and went to Galilee.

A Prophet has no honor in his own country

44 For Jesus Himself testified that a prophet has no honor in his own country.

Welcome in Galilee

45 So when He came to Galilee, the Galileans received Him, having seen all the things He did in Jerusalem at the feast; for they also had gone to the feast.

Capernaum Nobleman's Son – Healed from Long Distance

46 So Jesus came again to Cana of Galilee where He had made the water wine. And there was a certain nobleman whose son was sick at Capernaum. 47 When he heard that Jesus had come out of Judea into Galilee, he went to Him and implored Him to come down and heal his son, for he was at the point of death. 48 Then Jesus said to him, "Unless you people see signs and wonders, you will by no means believe." 49 The nobleman said to Him, "Sir, come down before my child dies!"

50 Jesus said to him, "Go your way; your son lives." So the man believed the word that Jesus spoke to him, and he went his way. 51 And as he was now going down, his servants met him and told him, saying, "Your son lives!" 52 Then he inquired of them the hour when he got better. And they said to him, "Yesterday at the seventh hour the fever left him." 53 So the father knew that it was at the same hour in which Jesus said to him, "Your son lives." And he himself believed, and his whole household. 54 This again is the second sign Jesus did when He had come out of Judea into Galilee.

✚ After Jesus spent two days at Sychar with the Samaritans, He departed and went to Galilee. [\[John 4:40, 43\]](#)

Capernaum Nobleman's Son – Healed from Long Distance

✚ Jesus came again to Cana of Galilee where He had made the water wine. [\[John 4:46\]](#)

✧ A Nobleman in Capernaum had a son who was dying, when he heard that Jesus had come to Galilee from Judea, he came to Cana to meet Jesus. [\[John 4:46-47\]](#)

✧ The Nobleman implored Jesus to come down and heal his son. [\[John 4:47\]](#)

✧ Jesus rebuked them for needing to see signs and wonders to believe. [\[John 4:48\]](#)

✧ The nobleman said to Him, "Sir, come down before my child dies!" [\[John 4:49\]](#)

✧ Jesus said to him, "Go your way; your son lives." [\[John 4:50\]](#)

✧ The Nobleman believed the word Jesus had spoken, and went his way, till his servants met him with news that the son lives. [\[John 4:51\]](#)

✧ The Nobleman inquired as to the time his son turned for the better and learned it was the same time Jesus had said, "Go your way, your son lives." [\[John 4:52\]](#)

✧ The Nobleman and his whole house believed the evidence. [\[John 4:53\]](#)

✝ This again is the second sign Jesus did when He had come out of Judea into Galilee. [[John 4:54](#)]
