Inheritance of Joseph in the Promised Land - Manasseh and Ephraim

¹ The lot fell to the children of Joseph from the Jordan, by Jericho, to the waters of Jericho on the east, to the wilderness that goes up from Jericho through the mountains to Bethel, ² then went out from Bethel to Luz, passed along to the border of the Archites at Ataroth, ³ and went down westward to the boundary of the Japhletites, as far as the boundary of Lower Beth Horon to Gezer; and it ended at the sea. ⁴ So the children of Joseph, Manasseh and Ephraim, took their inheritance.

Ephraim

⁵ The border of the children of Ephraim, according to their families, was thus: The border of their inheritance on the east side was Ataroth Addar as far as Upper Beth Horon. ⁶ And the border went out toward the sea on the north side of Michmethath; then the border went around eastward to Taanath Shiloh, and passed by it on the east of Janohah. ⁷ Then it went down from Janohah to Ataroth and Naarah, reached to Jericho, and came out at the Jordan. ⁸ The border went out from Tappuah westward to the Brook Kanah, and it ended at the sea. This was the inheritance of the tribe of the children of Ephraim according to their families. ⁹ The separate cities for the children of Ephraim were among the inheritance of the children of Manasseh, all the cities with their villages. ¹⁰ And they did not drive out the Canaanites who dwelt in Gezer; but the Canaanites dwell among the Ephraimites to this day and have become forced laborers.

Joshua 17

Manasseh

^{17:1} There was also a lot for the tribe of Manasseh, for he was the firstborn of Joseph: namely for Machir the firstborn of Manasseh, the father of Gilead, because he was a man of war; therefore he was given Gilead and Bashan. ² And there was a lot for the rest of the children of Manasseh according to their families: for the children of Abiezer, the children of Helek, the children of Asriel, the children of Shechem, the children of Hepher, and the children of Shemida; these were the male children of Manasseh the son of Joseph according to their families.

³ But Zelophehad the son of Hepher, the son of Gilead, the son of Machir, the son of Manasseh, had no sons, but only daughters. And these are the names of his daughters: Mahlah, Noah, Hoglah, Milcah, and Tirzah. ⁴ And they came near before Eleazar the priest, before Joshua the son of Nun, and before the rulers, saying, "The LORD commanded Moses to give us an inheritance among our brothers." Therefore, according to the commandment of the LORD, he gave them an inheritance among their father's brothers. ⁵ Ten shares fell to Manasseh, besides the land of Gilead and Bashan, which were on the other side of the Jordan, ⁶ because the daughters of Manasseh received an inheritance among his sons; and the rest of Manasseh's sons had the land of Gilead.

7 And the territory of Manasseh was from Asher to Michmethath, that lies east of Shechem; and the border went along south to the inhabitants of En Tappuah. 8 Manasseh had the land of Tappuah, but Tappuah on the border of Manasseh belonged to the children of Ephraim. 9 And the border descended to the Brook Kanah, southward to the brook. These cities of Ephraim are among the cities of Manasseh. The border of Manasseh was on the north side of the brook; and it ended at the sea. 10 Southward it was Ephraim's, northward it was Manasseh's, and the sea was its border. Manasseh's territory was adjoining Asher on the north and Issachar on the east. 11 And in Issachar and in Asher, Manasseh had Beth Shean and its towns, Ibleam and its towns, the inhabitants of Dor

and its towns, the inhabitants of En Dor and its towns, the inhabitants of Taanach and its towns, and the inhabitants of Megiddo and its towns--three hilly regions. ¹² Yet the children of Manasseh could not drive out the inhabitants of those cities, but the Canaanites were determined to dwell in that land. ¹³ And it happened, when the children of Israel grew strong, that they put the Canaanites to forced labor, but did not utterly drive them out.

Ephraim and Manasseh want more

☆ 5 The border of the children of Ephraim, according to their families, was thus:

The border of their inheritance on the <u>east side was Ataroth Addar as far as Upper Beth</u> <u>Horon</u>. 6 And the border went out <u>toward the sea on the north side of Michmethath</u>; then the border went around <u>eastward to Taanath Shiloh</u>, and passed by it on the <u>east of</u> <u>Janohah</u>. 7 Then it went down from <u>Janohah to Ataroth and Naarah</u>, reached to Jericho, and <u>came out at the Jordan</u>.

⁸ The border went out from <u>Tappuah westward to the Brook Kanah</u>, and it <u>ended at the sea</u> (Mediterranean Sea).

Failure to drive out

☆ 10 And they did not drive out the Canaanites who dwelt in Gezer; but the Canaanites dwell among the Ephraimites to this day and have become forced laborers. [Joshua 16:10]

Daughters of Zelophehad of the tribe of Manasseh [Joshua 17:3-6]

But Zelophehad the son of Hepher, the son of Gilead, the son of Machir, the son of Manasseh, had no sons, but only daughters. And these are the names of his daughters: Mahlah, Noah, Hoglah, Milcah, and Tirzah.

⁴ And they came near before Eleazar the priest, before Joshua the son of Nun, and before the rulers, saying,

"The LORD commanded Moses to give us an inheritance among our brothers." Therefore, according to the commandment of the LORD, he gave them an inheritance among their father's brothers.

⁵ <u>Ten shares fell to Manasseh, besides the land of Gilead and Bashan</u>, which were on the other side of the Jordan, 6 because the daughters of Manasseh received an inheritance among his sons; and the rest of Manasseh's sons had the land of Gilead.

- ☆ 7 And the territory of Manasseh was from <u>Asher to Michmethath</u>, that lies east of Shechem; and the border went along <u>south to the inhabitants of En Tappuah</u>. 8 Manasseh had the <u>land of</u> <u>Tappuah</u>, but Tappuah on the border of Manasseh belonged to the children of Ephraim. 9 And the border <u>descended to the Brook Kanah</u>, southward to the brook. These cities of Ephraim are among the cities of Manasseh. [Joshua 17:7-9]
- ☆ The border of Manasseh was on the north side of the brook; and it ended at the sea (Mediterranean Sea) [Joshua 17:9]

10 Southward it was Ephraim's, northward it was Manasseh's, and the sea was its border. **Manasseh's territory** was adjoining <u>Asher on the north</u> and <u>Issachar on the east</u>. 11 And in Issachar and in Asher, Manasseh had <u>Beth Shean</u> and its towns, <u>Ibleam</u> and its towns, the inhabitants of <u>Dor</u> and its towns, the inhabitants of <u>En Dor</u> and its towns, the inhabitants of <u>Taanach and its towns</u>, and the inhabitants of <u>Megiddo and its towns</u>--three hilly regions. [Joshua 17:10-11]

Failure of Manasseh to drive out

12 Yet the children of Manasseh could not drive out the inhabitants of those cities, but the Canaanites were determined to dwell in that land. 13 And it happened, when the children of Israel grew strong, that they put the Canaanites to forced labor, but did not utterly drive them out. [Joshua 17:12-13]

Ephraim and Manasseh want more [Joshua 17:14-18]

✿ 14 Then the children of Joseph spoke to Joshua, saying,

"Why have you given us only one lot and one share to inherit, since we are a great people, inasmuch as the LORD has blessed us until now?"

 \Rightarrow 15 So Joshua answered them,

"If you are a great people, then go up to the forest country and clear a place for yourself there in the <u>land of the Perizzites and the giants</u>, since the mountains of Ephraim are too confined for you."

 \Rightarrow 16 But the children of Joseph said,

"The mountain country is not enough for us; and all the Canaanites who dwell in the land of the valley have chariots of iron, both those who are of <u>Beth Shean and its</u> towns and those who are of the <u>Valley of Jezreel</u>."
