Judges 13:1-25 **Samson – Conception to manhood**

Israel Sinned

Again the children of Israel did evil in the sight of the LORD, and the LORD delivered them into the hand of the Philistines for forty years.

Appearance of Malek Yehowah to wife of Manoah

- ² Now there was a certain man from Zorah, of the family of the Danites, whose name was Manoah; and his wife was barren and had no children. ³ And the Angel of the LORD appeared to the woman and said to her, "Indeed now, you are barren and have borne no children, but you shall conceive and bear a son. ⁴ Now therefore, please be careful not to drink wine or similar drink, and not to eat anything unclean. ⁵ For behold, you shall conceive and bear a son. And no razor shall come upon his head, for the child shall be a Nazirite to God from the womb; and he shall begin to deliver Israel out of the hand of the Philistines."
- ⁶ So the woman came and told her husband, saying, "A Man of God came to me, and His countenance was like the countenance of the Angel of God, very awesome; but I did not ask Him where He was from, and He did not tell me His name. ⁷ And He said to me, 'Behold, you shall conceive and bear a son. Now drink no wine or similar drink, nor eat anything unclean, for the child shall be a Nazirite to God from the womb to the day of his death.' "

Manoah prayed – Malek Yehowah appeared to him

- 8 Then Manoah prayed to the LORD, and said, "O my Lord, please let the Man of God whom You sent come to us again and teach us what we shall do for the child who will be born." 9 And God listened to the voice of Manoah, and the Angel of God came to the woman again as she was sitting in the field; but Manoah her husband was not with her. 10 Then the woman ran in haste and told her husband, and said to him, "Look, the Man who came to me the other day has just now appeared to me!" 11 So Manoah arose and followed his wife. When he came to the Man, he said to Him, "Are You the Man who spoke to this woman?" And He said, "I am." 12 Manoah said, "Now let Your words come to pass! What will be the boy's rule of life, and his work?" 13 So the Angel of the LORD said to Manoah, "Of all that I said to the woman let her be careful. 14 She may not eat anything that comes from the vine, nor may she drink wine or similar drink, nor eat anything unclean. All that I commanded her let her observe."
- 15 Then Manoah said to the Angel of the LORD, "Please let us detain You, and we will prepare a young goat for You." 16 And the Angel of the LORD said to Manoah, "Though you detain Me, I will not eat your food. But if you offer a burnt offering, you must offer it to the LORD." (For Manoah did not know He was the Angel of the LORD.) 17 Then Manoah said to the Angel of the LORD, "What is Your name, that when Your words come to pass we may honor You?" 18 And the Angel of the LORD said to him, "Why do you ask My name, seeing it is wonderful?" 19 So Manoah took the young goat with the grain offering, and offered it upon the rock to the LORD. grain offering from our hands, nor would He have shown us all these things, nor would He have told us such things as these at this time."

Birth to manhood of Samson

²⁴ So the woman bore a son and called his name Samson; and the child grew, and the LORD blessed him. ²⁵ And the Spirit of the LORD began to move upon him at Mahaneh Dan between Zorah and Eshtaol. NKJV

Facts Revealed:

Israel Sinned

As the Scripture said:

Judges 2:19

 19 And it came to pass, when the judge was dead, that they reverted and behaved more corruptly than their fathers, by following other gods, to serve them and bow down to them. They did not cease from their own doings nor from their stubborn way. $\,NKJV$

- Yehowah used other nations to punish His people for their sins, in this case He used the Philistines against Israel. [Judges 4:1-2]
- ☆ Again the children of Israel did evil in the sight of Yehowah (the LORD), and Yehowah (the LORD) delivered them into the hand of the Philistines for forty years. [Judges 13:1]

Appearance of Malek Yehowah to wife of Manoah – Her report to Manoah [Judges 13:2-7]

- ☆ Manoah was of the tribe of Dan who lived in Zorah, and his wife was barren and had no children. [Judges 13:2]
- **★ Malek Yehowah** (the angel of the LORD) appeared to the wife of Manoah and said:
 - ♦ "Indeed now, you are barren and have borne no children, but you shall conceive and bear
 a son. [Judges 13:3]
 - ♦ Now therefore, please **be careful not to drink wine or similar drink, and not to eat anything unclean**. [Judges 13:4]
 - ♦ For behold, you shall conceive and bear a son. [Judges 13:5]
 - ♦ And no razor shall come upon his head, for the child shall be a Nazirite to God from the womb; [Judges 13:5]
 - ♦ and he shall begin to deliver Israel out of the hand of the Philistines." [Judges 13:5]
 - The child is to be a Nazarite from the womb, so the mother is to follow the dietary laws of the Nazarite, involving abstinence from wine or similar drink and from unclean food.

 [Numbers 6:1-5]
 - If The child will be a miracle child since the mother is barren.
 - If The child will be a son who will **begin** to deliver Israel from the Philistines.
- **☼** The woman described the visit of **Malek Yehowah** to her husband: [Judges 13:6-7]
 - ❖ A Man of Elohiym (God) came to me, and His countenance was like the countenance of the Malek Elohiym (Angel of God), very awesome; but I did not ask Him where He was from, and He did not tell me His name. [Judges 13:6]
 - ♦ He said to me, "Behold, you shall conceive and bear a son. Now drink no wine or similar drink, nor eat anything unclean, for the child shall be a Nazirite to God from the womb to the day of his death." [Judges 13:7]

Manoah prayed – Malek Yehowah appeared to him [Judges 13:8-23]

- ♦ Manoah prayed to Yehowah (the LORD), and said, "O Adoney my Lord, please let the Man of Elohiym (God) whom You sent come to us again and teach us what we shall do for the child who will be born." [Judges 13:8]
- - → God's message was to the woman, not to the man, so He came to the woman, however He allowed Manoah to witness the visit.
 - ♦ Manoah's wife informed Manoah that the man had reappeared, so Manoah went with her to the man, and asked, .Are You the Man who spoke to this woman?" [Judges 13:10-11]
 - ♦ The Man said, "I Am." [Judges 13:11]
 - ♦ Manoah said, "Now let Your words come to pass! What will be the boy's rule of life, and his work?" [Judges 13:12]
 - ♦ Malek Yehowah said to Manoah, "Of all that I said to the woman let her be careful. She may not eat anything that comes from the vine, nor may she drink wine or similar drink, nor eat anything unclean. All that I commanded her let her observe." [Judges 13:13-14]
 - ☐ The message originally given to the woman still stands, the **dietary law of the Nazirite** applies to the mother because the child will be a Nazirite from the womb. [Numbers 6:1-5]
 - ♦ Then Manoah said to Malek Yehowah (the Angel of the LORD), "Please let us detain You, and we will prepare a young goat for You." [Judges 13:15]
 - ♦ And Malek Yehowah said to Manoah, "Though you detain Me, I will not eat your food. But if you offer a burnt offering, you must offer it to Yehowah (the LORD)." (For Manoah did not know He was Malek Yehowah (the Angel of the LORD.) [Judges 13:16]
 - ♦ Then Manoah said to Malek Yehowah (the Angel of the LORD), "What is Your name, that when Your words come to pass we may honor You?" [Judges 13:17]
 - ♦ Malek Yehowah (the Angel of the LORD) said to him, "Why do you ask My name, seeing it is pela (wonderful, secret, mystery)?" [Judges 13:18]
 - ♦ So Manoah took the young goat with the grain offering, and offered it upon the rock to Yehowah (the LORD). [Judges 13:19]
 - ♦ And He did a wondrous thing while Manoah and his wife looked on-- it happened as the flame went up toward heaven from the altar-- Malek Yehowah (the Angel of the LORD) ascended in the flame of the altar! [Judges 13:19-20]
 - ♦ When Manoah and his wife saw this, they fell on their faces to the ground. When Malek Yehowah (the Angel of the LORD) appeared no more to Manoah and his wife, then Manoah knew that He was Malek Yehowah (the Angel of the LORD). And Manoah said to his wife, "We shall surely die, because we have seen Elohiym (God)!" [Judges 13:20-22]
 - ♦ But his wife said to him, "If Yehowah (the LORD) had desired to kill us, He would not have accepted a burnt offering and a grain offering from our hands, nor would He have shown us all these things, nor would He have told us such things as these at this time." [Judges 13:23]

Birth to manhood of Samson

- ❖ So the woman bore a son and called his name **Samson**; and the child grew, and Yehowah blessed him. [Judges 13:24]
- And Ruach Yehowah (the Spirit of the LORD) began to move upon him at Mahaneh Dan between Zorah and Eshtaol.
 [Judges 13:25]
 - ♦ The Holy Spirit was discernable in Samson and began to move upon him influencing his actions and abilities.
