

Leviticus 17:1-9 **Location for all Sacrifices to be made to Yehowah**

¹ And the LORD spoke to Moses, saying, ² "Speak to Aaron, to his sons, and to all the children of Israel, and say to them, 'This is the thing which the LORD has commanded, saying:

³ "Whatever man of the house of Israel who kills an ox or lamb or goat in the camp, or who kills it outside the camp, ⁴ and does not bring it to the door of the tabernacle of meeting to offer an offering to the LORD before the tabernacle of the LORD, the guilt of bloodshed shall be imputed to that man. He has shed blood; and that man shall be cut off from among his people,

⁵ to the end that the children of Israel may bring their sacrifices which they offer in the open field, that they may bring them to the LORD at the door of the tabernacle of meeting, to the priest, and offer them as peace offerings to the LORD. ⁶ And the priest shall sprinkle the blood on the altar of the LORD at the door of the tabernacle of meeting, and burn the fat for a sweet aroma to the LORD.

⁷ They shall no more offer their sacrifices to demons, after whom they have played the harlot. This shall be a statute forever for them throughout their generations." '

⁸ "Also you shall say to them: 'Whatever man of the house of Israel, or of the strangers who dwell among you, who offers a burnt offering or sacrifice, ⁹ and does not bring it to the door of the tabernacle of meeting, to offer it to the LORD, that man shall be cut off from among his people. NKJV

Facts Revealed:

- ✧ Any animal killed as an offering to express worship, whether of ox, sheep, or goat must be brought before Yehowah at the door of the Tabernacle of Meeting.
- ✧ Anyone failing to do so will be cut off from among his people.
- ✧ The intent is to cause the people to bring the sacrifices they are offering in the open field, to Yehowah to be offered as a Peace Offering, where the Priest can sprinkle the blood on the altar of Yehowah at the door of the Tabernacle of Meeting and burn the fat as a sweet aroma to Yehowah.
- ✧ It is to turn them from offering their sacrifices to demons, whom they are pursuing.
- ✧ The Statute is an everlasting Statute throughout their generations.
- ✧ Whoever offers a sacrifice in any other place and to any other than Yehowah shall be cut off from among his people.
- ✧ This is another call to the Children of Israel to depart from all forms of Idolatry.
