¹ Then He spoke a parable to them, that men always ought to pray and not lose heart, ² saying:

"There was in a certain city a judge who did not fear God nor regard man. 3 Now there was a widow in that city; and she came to him, saying, 'Get justice for me from my adversary.' 4 And he would not for a while; but afterward he said within himself, 'Though I do not fear God nor regard man, 5 yet because this widow troubles me I will avenge her, lest by her continual coming she weary me.' Facts Revealed:

- The point of the story is that Jesus wants us to persist in prayer when adversity comes and not to become discouraged.
 - ♦ Like in most of the parables regarding the coming of the Kingdom, there is a time delay between the promise and the actually coming of the Lord.
 - \diamond When the time comes for the end to take place, it will happen quickly.
 - ♦ God is looking for those who will be faithfully living obedient lives expectantly watching for the time of His Return.
 - ♦ The important question is, "When the Son of Man comes, will He really find faith on the earth?"
 - ♦ Jesus certainly will come, and when He does, will you be living holy and righteous while watching eagerly and expectantly when He comes?
 - \diamond Will you be able to recognize the signs that announce His coming?
 - ♦ Or will you blindly be so wrapped up in your own selfish world that you will fail to be ready when He does come?
 - ☆ Remember, Jesus said, "Watch therefore, and pray always that you may be counted worthy to escape all these things that will come to pass, and to stand before the Son of Man." [Luke 21:36]
 - \Rightarrow If you do, you will receive the reward of the overcomers and faithful. [Luke 12:43-44, Matthew 24:46-47]
 - ♦ When Jesus comes to set up His Kingdom, He will reward the Saints. [Revelation 11:16-18, Matthew 16:27, Revelation 22:12, Mark 8:38, Luke 9:26]
 - ★ The Rewards will be marvelous. [Job 19:25-27, Micah 7:18-19, Isaiah 55:6-13, 56:1-8, 57:13b-19, 59:20-21, Jeremiah 31:31-34, Psalm 73:24, Matthew 25:29, 34, John 5:25-29, 1 Corinthians 6:1-3, 13:12, 1 Thessalonians 2:19-20, 2 Thessalonians 1:7, 2:13-14, 2 Timothy 4:8, Hebrews 8:7-12, 10:14-17, 12:28-29, James 1:12, 1 Peter 5:4, 1 John 2:28, 3:2, Revelation 1:4-6, 2:10, 2:7b, 2:11b, 2:17b, 2:26-28, 3:4-5, 3:9, 3:10, 3:11-12a, 3:12b, 3:21, 5:8-10]
 - ♦ If you don't, you will receive a very unpleasant surprise and be judged with the unbelievers and hypocrites.
 - The one who, because of the time delay, scoffs at the probability of the Master's coming, and who begins to live like the worldly people around him; [Matthew 24:48-51, Luke 12:45-46, 2 Peter 3:3-4, Jude 1:17-18]
 - □ Will suddenly find himself facing the wrath of the Master, as he receives the punishment met out for the hypocrites and unbelievers. [Matthew 24:50-51, Luke 12:45-46]

- \diamond We are expected to remain faithful until He arrives.
