12 Now it came to pass in those days that He went out to the mountain to pray, and continued all night in prayer to God. 13 And when it was day, He called His disciples to Himself; and from them He chose twelve whom He also named apostles: 14 Simon, whom He also named Peter, and Andrew his brother; James and John; Philip and Bartholomew; 15 Matthew and Thomas; James the son of Alphaeus, and Simon called the Zealot; 16 Judas the son of James, and Judas Iscariot who also became a traitor. - ₽ Jesus went up on the mountain and called the twelve He wanted to be with Him and to send them out to preach. [Mark 3:13-14, Matthew 10:1, Luke 6:13]

- ₱ James and John the sons of Zebedee were called Boanerges, that is, "Sons of Thunder" [Mark 3:17]
- † Thaddaeus was the surname of Lebbaeus. [Matthew 10:3]
- \$\frac{1}{2}\$ Simon is called the Canaanite, the Cananite, the Cananaean, and the Zealot depending on the translation and the choice of the translators.
  - ♦ Canaanite would suggest a descendant of the original race who inhabited the land before Israel was given it as an inheritance.

  - ♦ Zealot would suggest a membership in a group of Jews set to the overthrow of the Roman occupation of the land.
  - ♦ The Greek word being translated is Kananites or Kananaíos depending on the Greek version being translated.
- Jesus gave them power to heal all kinds of sickness and all kinds of disease, and over unclean spirits (demons), to cast them out, . [Matthew 10:1, Mark 3:15, 6:7, Luke 9:1]
  - ♦ And they went in to the House. [Mark 3:19]
