## Luke 6:46-49 Wise Hearer or Foolish hearer

46 "But why do you call Me 'Lord, Lord,' and do not do the things which I say?

<sup>47</sup> Whoever comes to Me, and hears My sayings and does them, I will show you whom he is like: <sup>48</sup> He is like a man building a house, who dug deep and laid the foundation on the rock. And when the flood arose, the stream beat vehemently against that house, and could not shake it, for it was founded on the rock.

<sup>49</sup> But he who heard and did nothing is like a man who built a house on the earth without a foundation, against which the stream beat vehemently; and immediately it fell. And the ruin of that house was great." NKJV

## Facts Revealed

Obedience is wisdom / Disobedience is foolishness [Matthew 7:24-27, Luke 6:46-49]

- The wise man, is the one who hears the teachings of Jesus and puts them to practice in his life.
  - ♦ His destiny is secure, standing on the solid Rock which is Christ Jesus. [1 Corinthians 1:4, 3:11]
- The foolish man, is the one who hears the teachings of Jesus and does not do what is taught.
  - His destiny is destruction, built on his own foundation, not doing the will of God, nor keeping the commandments of Jesus. [Romans 2:1-16, 10:1-3, Philippians 3:18-19, 2 Thessalonians 1:3-9, 1 Peter 4:17]
- The things being referred to here are the things taught in the Sermon on the Mount [Matthew 5:1 through 7:23 and Luke 6:20-45], yet when you come to the end of Matthew, you discover it includes everything Jesus taught in His entire ministry. [Matthew 28:20]
