

Matthew 14:34-36 Many Healed - Touching His Garment

³⁴ When they had crossed over, they came to the land of Gennesaret. ³⁵ And when the men of that place recognized Him, they sent out into all that surrounding region, brought to Him all who were sick, ³⁶ and begged Him that they might only touch the hem of His garment. And as many as touched it were made perfectly well. NKJV

Facts Revealed:

Many Healed touching the hem of Jesus' garment [Matthew 14:34-36, Mark 6:53-56]

- † The hem of the garment is also called wings fulfilling the prophecy that says, "But to you who fear My name The Sun of Righteousness shall arise With healing in His wings." [Malachi 4:2]
 - ✧ The reference is to the Prayer Shawl worn by Jewish men, and speaks of the tassels God commanded them to put in the hem of their garments. [Numbers 15:37-39, Deuteronomy 22:12]
 - ✧ It was these tassels the people touched and received their healing. [Matthew 14:34-36, Mark 6:53-56, Luke 6:17-19]
 - ✧ As many as touched it, were made perfectly well. [Matthew 14:36]
 - ✧ Jesus is therefore identified as the "Sun of Righteousness" of Old Testament Prophecy. [Malachi 4:2]
 - ✧ Jesus said to the two on the way to Emmaus: "O foolish ones, and slow of heart to believe in all that the prophets have spoken! Ought not the Christ to have suffered these things and to enter into His glory?" And **beginning at Moses and all the Prophets, He expounded to them in all the Scriptures the things concerning Himself.** [Luke 24:25-27]
 - ✧ Then later to the Disciples after the two reported seeing Jesus on the road and in Emmaus, Jesus appeared and said: "These are the words which I spoke to you while I was still with you, that **all things must be fulfilled which were written in the Law of Moses and the Prophets and the Psalms concerning Me.**" [Luke 24:44]
