## Facts Revealed:

- \$\frac{1}{4}\$ Jesus is on His way to Jerusalem for the last Passover. [Matthew 19:1-2, Mark 10:1, Luke 17:11, John 11:55]
- ₱ Jesus left Galilee and came to the region of Judea beyond the Jordan.
  - ♦ That would be east of the Jordan River where Moses wrote the book of Deuteronomy before the Children of Israel crossed over into the land of Canaan, from the area of Acacia Grove in plain of Moab. [Numbers 22:1, Deuteronomy 32:48-52, 34:1-8, Joshua 2:1, 3:1, 14-17]
  - ♦ This would also be near Bethabara where John the Baptist was baptizing the people. [John 1:28]
- ♣ Great multitudes followed Him and He healed them there. [Matthew 19:2]
  - ♦ As was His custom Jesus taught them there. [Mark 10:1]
