14 Then one of the twelve, called Judas Iscariot, went to the chief priests 15 and said, "What are you willing to give me if I deliver Him to you?" And they counted out to him thirty pieces of silver. 16 So from that time he sought opportunity to betray Him. NKJV

Facts Revealed:

- Judas Iscariot the disciple who acted as the treasurer and carried the money box for the disciples, was also a thief who would steel money from it. [John 12:4-6]
 - → Judas went to the Chief Priests and agreed to betray Jesus for thirty pieces of silver.

 [Matthew 26:14-15, Mark 14:10-11, Luke 22:3-6]
 - → Judas was given the money from the Chief Priest and began looking for an opportunity to betray Jesus. [Matthew 26:16]
