

## Numbers 28:16-25 **Offerings at Feasts of Yehowah:**

### **Passover – Unleavened Bread**

<sup>16</sup> 'On the fourteenth day of the first month is the Passover of the LORD. <sup>17</sup> And on the fifteenth day of this month is the feast; unleavened bread shall be eaten for seven days. <sup>18</sup> On the first day you shall have a holy convocation. You shall do no customary work. <sup>19</sup> And you shall present an offering made by fire as a burnt offering to the LORD: two young bulls, one ram, and seven lambs in their first year. Be sure they are without blemish. <sup>20</sup> Their grain offering shall be of fine flour mixed with oil: three-tenths of an ephah you shall offer for a bull, and two-tenths for a ram; <sup>21</sup> you shall offer one-tenth of an ephah for each of the seven lambs; <sup>22</sup> also one goat as a sin offering, to make atonement for you. <sup>23</sup> You shall offer these besides the burnt offering of the morning, which is for a regular burnt offering. <sup>24</sup> In this manner you shall offer the food of the offering made by fire daily for seven days, as a sweet aroma to the LORD; it shall be offered besides the regular burnt offering and its drink offering. <sup>25</sup> And on the seventh day you shall have a holy convocation. You shall do no customary work. NKJV

### Numbers 28:26-31 **Firstfruits – Feast of Weeks**

<sup>26</sup> 'Also on the day of the firstfruits, when you bring a new grain offering to the LORD at your Feast of Weeks, you shall have a holy convocation. You shall do no customary work. <sup>27</sup> You shall present a burnt offering as a sweet aroma to the LORD: two young bulls, one ram, and seven lambs in their first year, <sup>28</sup> with their grain offering of fine flour mixed with oil: three-tenths of an ephah for each bull, two-tenths for the one ram, <sup>29</sup> and one-tenth for each of the seven lambs; <sup>30</sup> also one kid of the goats, to make atonement for you. <sup>31</sup> Be sure they are without blemish. You shall present them with their drink offerings, besides the regular burnt offering with its grain offering. NKJV

#### Facts Revealed:

- ✧ Since God is the inheritance of the Priests and Levites, God provides food for them by saying, “My offering, My food for My offerings made by fire as a sweet aroma to Me, you shall be careful to offer to Me at their appointed time.” [Numbers 18:20-32, 28:1-2]
- ✧ This provides food for those appointed no inheritance who are dependant on God’s offerings for their sustenance. [Numbers 28:1-2]
- ✧ All the Feasts of Yehowah are appointed by God in both time and substance.
- ✧ Each has its own significance as noted at its first occurrence.

### **Passover – Unleavened Bread**

- ✧ Passover is on the 14<sup>th</sup> day of the first month, and it is a celebration to Yehowah. [Exodus 12:1-13, 21-27, Leviticus 23:5, Numbers 9:1-14]
- ✧ Unleavened Bread is a seven day feast that begins on the 15<sup>th</sup> day of the first month. [Exodus 12:15-20, 13:3-10, 23:15, 34:18, Leviticus 23:6-8]
  - ✧ Unleavened bread is to be eaten for the seven days.
  - ✧ The first day is a day of holy assembly to honor God.
  - ✧ No customary work is to be performed on that day.
  - ✧ **Burnt Offerings** to be presented to Yehowah are:
    - 2 young bulls
    - 1 ram
    - 7 lambs in their first year.
    - (All are to be without blemish)
    - Grain Offering of fine flour mixed with oil;

Three tenths ephah for each bull  
Two tenths ephah for a ram  
One tenth ephah for each lamb

✧ **Sin Offering**

1 goat to make atonement for you.

- ✧ These are to be offered daily for seven days.
- ✧ These are in addition to the regular morning Burnt Offerings and their Drink Offerings. [\[Numbers 28:1-15\]](#)
- ✧ The seventh day is a day of holy assembly to honor God.
- ✧ No customary work is to be performed on that day.

## **Firstfruits – Feast of Weeks**

- ✧ On the Day of First-Fruits, when you bring a new Grain Offering to Yehowah at your Feast of Weeks (Pentecost):
  - ✧ You shall have a holy assembly to honor God.
  - ✧ No customary work is to be performed on that day.
  - ✧ **Burnt Offerings** to be presented as a sweet aroma to Yehowah are:
    - 2 young bulls
    - 1 ram
    - 7 lambs in their first year.
    - Grain Offering of fine flour mixed with oil;
      - Three tenths ephah for each bull
      - Two tenths ephah for a ram
      - One tenth ephah for each lamb
  - ✧ **Sin Offering**
    - 1 kid of the goats, to make atonement for you.
    - (All are to be without blemish)
  - ✧ They are to be presented with their Drink Offerings.
- ✧ These are in addition to the regular morning Burnt Offering and its Grain Offerings. [\[Numbers 28:1-15\]](#)
