Psalm 10:1-18 Ways of the Wicked – Confidence in Yahweh's Judgment

A Song of Confidence in God's Triumph over Evil

1 Why do You stand afar off, O Yahweh (Lord)? Why do You hide in times of trouble?

Ways of the wicked described

- 2 The wicked in his pride persecutes the poor; Let them be caught in the plots which they have devised.
- ³ For the wicked boasts of his heart's desire; He blesses the greedy and renounces Yahweh (the Lord)
- ⁴ The wicked in his proud countenance does not seek God; Elohiym (God) is in none of his thoughts.
- ⁵ His ways are always prospering; Your judgments are far above, out of his sight; As for all his enemies, he sneers at them.
- 6 He has said in his heart, "I shall not be moved; I shall never be in adversity."
- ⁷ His mouth is full of cursing and deceit and oppression; Under his tongue is trouble and iniquity.
- 8 He sits in the lurking places of the villages; In the secret places he murders the innocent; His eyes are secretly fixed on the helpless.
- 9 He lies in wait secretly, as a lion in his den; He lies in wait to catch the poor; He catches the poor when he draws him into his net.
- 10 So he crouches, he lies low, That the helpless may fall by his strength.
- 11 He has said in his heart, "El (God) has forgotten; He hides His face; He will never see."
- 12 Arise, O Yahweh (Lord)! O El (God), lift up Your hand! Do not forget the humble.
- 13 Why do the wicked renounce Elohiym (God)? He has said in his heart, "You will not require an account."

Confidence in Yahweh's coming Judgment against the wicked

- 14 But You have seen, for You observe trouble and grief, To repay it by Your hand. The helpless commits himself to You; You are the helper of the fatherless.
- 15 Break the arm of the wicked and the evil man; Seek out his wickedness until You find none.
- 16 Yahweh (The Lord) is King forever and ever; The nations have perished out of His land.
- 17 Yahweh (Lord), You have heard the desire of the humble; You will prepare their heart; You will cause Your ear to hear,
- 18 To do justice to the fatherless and the oppressed, That the man of the earth may oppress no more. NKJV

Facts Revealed:

- ♥ Why do You stand afar off, O Yahweh (Lord)? Why do You hide in times of trouble? [Psalm 10:1]
 - ♦ It is so easy when troubles come to feel that our loving Yahweh stands far off and fails to punish the wicked speedily.
 - ♦ This concept is repeated many times in the Psalms.

♦ The answer is found in both the Old testament and the New. [2 Peter 3:9, Ezekiel chapters 18 & 33:1-20, Psalm 73:1-17]

The ways of the wicked described [Psalm 10:2-13]

- ♦ The wicked pridefully persecutes the poor,
- ♦ Boasts of his heart desire,
- ♦ Blesses the greedy,
- ♦ Renounces Yahweh,
- ♦ Elohiym is in none of his thoughts, nor does he seek Him,
- ♦ His ways always prosper, and he sneers at his enemies,
- ♦ Yahweh's judgments are far above him and out of his sight,
- ♦ He has said in his heart, "I shall not be moved; I shall never be in adversity."
- ♦ His mouth is full of cursing, deceit, & oppression,
- ♦ Iniquity and trouble are under his tongue,
- ♦ He lurks in secret places, and murders the innocent,
- ♦ His eyes are secretly fixed on the helpless,
- ♦ He has said in his heart, "El (God) has forgotten; He hides His face; He will never see."
- ♦ The wicked renounce Elohiym (God)? He has said in his heart, "You will not require an account."

Plea for Yahweh to arise and take action

♦ Arise, O Yahweh (Lord)! O El (God), lift up Your hand! Do not forget the humble.

Confidence in Yahweh's coming Judgment against the wicked [Psalm 10:14-18]

- ❖ Yahweh has seen and observed trouble and grief and will recompense evil on the wicked.
- ♦ The helpless commits himself to You; for You are the helper of the fatherless.
- ♦ (Prayer that Yahweh will) break the arm of the wicked and the evil man; Seek out his wickedness until You find none.

To do justice to the fatherless and the oppressed, That the man of the earth may oppress no more. [Psalm 10:16-18]
