A Song to the LORD Who Preserves and Prospers His People

A Psalm of David.

¹ Blessed *be* YAHWEH (the LORD) my Rock, Who trains my hands for war, *And* my fingers for battle

² My lovingkindness and my fortress, My high tower and my deliverer, My shield and *the One* in whom I take refuge, Who subdues my people* under me.

³ YAHWEH (LORD), what *is* man, that You take knowledge of him? *Or* the son of man, that You are mindful of him?

⁴ Man is like a breath; His days *are* like a passing shadow.

⁵ Bow down Your heavens, O YAHWEH (LORD), and come down; Touch the mountains, and they shall smoke.

⁶ Flash forth lightning and scatter them; Shoot out Your arrows and destroy them.

⁷ Stretch out Your hand from above; Rescue me and deliver me out of great waters, From the hand of foreigners,

⁸ Whose mouth speaks lying words, And whose right hand *is* a right hand of falsehood.

⁹ I will sing a new song to You, O Elohiym (God); On a harp of ten strings I will sing praises to You,

¹⁰ *The One* who gives salvation to kings, Who delivers David His servant From the deadly sword.

¹¹ Rescue me and deliver me from the hand of foreigners, Whose mouth speaks lying words, And whose right hand *is* a right hand of falsehood

¹² That our sons *may be* as plants grown up in their youth; *That* our daughters *may be* as pillars, Sculptured in palace style;

¹³ *That* our barns *may be* full, Supplying all kinds of produce; *That* our sheep may bring forth thousands And ten thousands in our fields;

¹⁴ *That* our oxen *may be* well laden; *That there be* no breaking in or going out; *That there be* no outcry in our streets.

✧ David blessed Yahweh and expressed the personal help he has experienced from Yahweh.

✧ YAHWEH (LORD), what *is* man, that You take knowledge of him? Or the son of man, that You are mindful of him?

Man is like a breath; His days *are* like a passing shadow. [Psalm 144:3-4]

✧ Considering the greatness of Yahweh, David expressed wonder that so great and mighty a God would be mindful of men who are so weak and inferior with so brief a life span.

✧ Bow down Your heavens, O YAHWEH (LORD), and come down; Touch the mountains, and they shall smoke.

Flash forth lightning and scatter them; Shoot out Your arrows and destroy them.

[Psalm 144:5-6]

✧ David described the great power of Yahweh in the heavens and earth.

✧ Stretch out Your hand from above; Rescue me and deliver me out of great waters, From the hand of foreigners,

Whose mouth speaks lying words, And whose right hand *is* a right hand of falsehood.

{psalm 144:7-8}

✧ David called on the great God for deliverance from deceitful foreigners.

✧ I will sing a new song to You, O Elohiym (God); On a harp of ten strings I will sing praises to You,

The One who gives salvation to kings, Who delivers David His servant From the deadly sword. [Psalm 144:9-10]

✧ David promised to sing a new song to Elohiym Who brings salvation to kings and protects David from those who seek his life.

✧ Rescue me and deliver me from the hand of foreigners, Whose mouth speaks lying words, And whose right hand *is* a right hand of falsehood

That our sons *may be* as plants grown up in their youth; *That* our daughters *may be* as pillars, Sculptured in palace style;

That our barns *may be* full, Supplying all kinds of produce; *That* our sheep may bring forth thousands And ten thousands in our fields;

That our oxen *may be* well laden; *That there be* no breaking in or going out; *That there be* no outcry in our streets.

✧ David again asked for deliverance from lying foreigners who work falsehood.

✧ David described the abundant good that will accompany such deliverance.

✧ **Happy are the people whose God is Yahweh**
