- I will wash my hands in innocence; So I will go about Your altar, O Yahweh (Lord), That I may proclaim with the voice of thanksgiving, And tell of all Your wondrous works. Yahweh (Lord), I have loved the habitation of Your house, And the place where Your glory dwells. [Psalm 26:6-8]
 - ☆ David has declared his intent to keep himself pure before Yahweh to enable him to give a clear testimony of Yahweh.
 - ♦ David expressed his love for being close to the presence of Yahweh.
- Do not gather my soul with sinners, Nor my life with bloodthirsty men,

In whose hands is a sinister scheme, And whose right hand is full of bribes. [Psalm 26:9-10]

 \diamond David does not want his soul to spend eternity with the wicked.

- But as for me, I will walk in my integrity; Redeem me and be merciful to me. My foot stands in an even place; In the congregations I will bless Yahweh (the Lord). [Psalm 26:11-12]
 - ♦ David expressed his intention to maintain his integrity like Job.
 - ♦ David is trusting in the mercy of Yahweh and looks to Him for redemption.
 - ♦ Confident in his relationship with Yahweh, David promised to publicly bless his God.
