 - ♦ Yahweh delights in obedience and a willing heart for which no sacrifice is needed.
- ➡ I have proclaimed the good news of righteousness In the great assembly; Indeed, I do not restrain my lips, O Yahweh (LORD), You Yourself know.

 I have not hidden Your righteousness within my heart; I have declared Your faithfulness and Your salvation; I have not concealed Your lovingkindness and Your truth From the great assembly. [Psalm 40:9-10]
 - ♦ David has not hesitated to publicly proclaim the righteousness, faithfulness, salvation loving-kindness and truth of Yahweh openly and in the great assembly.
- ☼ Do not withhold Your tender mercies from me, O Yahweh (LORD); Let Your lovingkindness and Your truth continually preserve me. For innumerable evils have surrounded me; My iniquities have overtaken me, so that I am not able to look up; They are more than the hairs of my head; Therefore my heart fails me. [Psalm 40:11-12]
 - ♦ David besought Yahweh to continue to show His tender mercy and loving kindness.
 - ♦ David acknowledged his sins and the overwhelming weight of a guilty conscience.
- Be pleased, O Yahweh (LORD), to deliver me; O Yahweh (LORD), make haste to help me!
 - Let them be ashamed and brought to mutual confusion Who seek to destroy my

life; Let them be driven backward and brought to dishonor Who wish me evil. Let them be confounded because of their shame, Who say to me, "Aha, aha!" [Psalm 40:13-15]

- ♦ David implored Yahweh to help and deliver him.
- ♦ David expressed a curse on his enemies all around him.
- ★ Let all those who seek You rejoice and be glad in You; Let such as love Your salvation say continually, "Yahweh (The LORD) be magnified!" [Psalm 40:16]
 - ♦ David pronounced a blessing on all who seek Yahweh and love His salvation.
- ★ But I am poor and needy; Yet Adonay (the LORD) thinks upon me.
 You are my help and my deliverer; Do not delay, O Elohay (my God). [Psalm 40:17]
 - ♦ David acknowledged his weakness and dependence upon Adonay.
 - ♦ David rejoiced that Adonay is mindful of him.
 - ♦ David acknowledged that Elohay is his help and deliverer.
