 - Yahweh Tsebaaovt (The LORD of hosts) *is* with us; Elohey (The God of) Jacob *is* our refuge. [Psalm 46:10-11]
 - ❖ During the Kingdom Age, Elohiym will be exalted as He in the person of Jesus will be King of kings and Lord of lords.
 - ♦ All the nations of the earth will come to Jerusalem to worship Him. [Isaiah 2:1-5, 11:10, 52:10, 60:3, Micah 4:1-8]
