

Psalm 50:1-23 **El Elohiym Yahweh the Righteous Judge in Zion**

*God the Righteous Judge*

A Psalm of Asaph.

<sup>1</sup>El Elohiym Yahweh (The Mighty One, God the LORD), Has spoken and called the earth From the rising of the sun to its going down.

<sup>2</sup>Out of Zion, the perfection of beauty, Elohiym (God) will shine forth.

<sup>3</sup>Eloheyuw (Our God) shall come, and shall not keep silent; A fire shall devour before Him, And it shall be very tempestuous all around Him.

<sup>4</sup>He shall call to the heavens from above, And to the earth, that He may judge His people:

<sup>5</sup>"Gather My saints together to Me, Those who have made a covenant with Me by sacrifice."

<sup>6</sup>Let the heavens declare His righteousness, For Elohiym (God) Himself *is* Judge.

<sup>7</sup>"Hear, O My people, and I will speak, O Israel, and I will testify against you; I am Elohiym Eloheyka (God, your God)!

<sup>8</sup>I will not rebuke you for your sacrifices Or your burnt offerings, *Which are* continually before Me.

<sup>9</sup>I will not take a bull from your house, *Nor* goats out of your folds.

<sup>10</sup>For every beast of the forest *is* Mine, *And* the cattle on a thousand hills.

<sup>11</sup>I know all the birds of the mountains, And the wild beasts of the field *are* Mine.

<sup>12</sup>"If I were hungry, I would not tell you; For the world *is* Mine, and all its fullness.

<sup>13</sup>Will I eat the flesh of bulls, Or drink the blood of goats?

<sup>14</sup>Offer to Elohiym (God) thanksgiving, And pay your vows to the Most High.

<sup>15</sup>Call upon Me in the day of trouble; I will deliver you, and you shall glorify Me."

<sup>16</sup>But to the wicked Elohiym (God) says:

"What *right* have you to declare My statutes, Or take My covenant in your mouth,

<sup>17</sup>Seeing you hate instruction And cast My words behind you?

<sup>18</sup>When you saw a thief, you consented\* with him, And have been a partaker with adulterers.

<sup>19</sup>You give your mouth to evil, And your tongue frames deceit.

<sup>20</sup>You sit *and* speak against your brother; You slander your own mother's son.

<sup>21</sup>These *things* you have done, and I kept silent;

You thought that I was altogether like you; *But* I will rebuke you, And set *them* in order before your eyes.

<sup>22</sup>"Now consider this, you who forget Elowah (God), Lest I tear *you* in pieces, And *there be* none to deliver:

<sup>23</sup>Whoever offers praise glorifies Me; And to him who orders *his* conduct *aright* I will show the salvation of Elohiym (God)."

Facts Revealed:

- ☆ Yahweh reigns in Zion as the righteous judge of His people. (Kingdom Age).
- ☆ "Hear, O My people, and I will speak, O Israel, and I will testify against you; I am Elohiym Eloheyka (God, your God)!  
I will not rebuke you for your sacrifices Or your burnt offerings, *Which are* continually before Me.  
I will not take a bull from your house, *Nor* goats out of your folds.  
For every beast of the forest *is* Mine, *And* the cattle on a thousand hills.  
I know all the birds of the mountains, And the wild beasts of the field *are* Mine.

- ☆ Everything on earth belongs to Elohiym by right of creation.
- ☆ He does not need our sacrifices for Himself, they are the penalty for our sins.
- ☆ Offer to Elohiym (God) thanksgiving, And pay your vows to the Most High.  
Call upon Me in the day of trouble; I will deliver you, and you shall glorify Me."  
But to the wicked Elohiym (God) says:  
"What *right* have you to declare My statutes, Or take My covenant in your mouth,  
Seeing you hate instruction And cast My words behind you?  
When you saw a thief, you consented\* with him, And have been a partaker with adulterers.  
You give your mouth to evil, And your tongue frames deceit.  
You sit *and* speak against your brother; You slander your own mother's son.  
These *things* you have done, and I kept silent;  
You thought that I was altogether like you; *But* I will rebuke you, And set *them* in order before your eyes. [Psalm 50:14-21]
- ☆ What Elohiym desires is for our own good.
- ☆ He desires our thanksgiving, paying our vows in faithfulness.
- ☆ He wants us to call on him with faith and trust in times of trouble, He will deliver us.
- ☆ He knows all the ways of the wicked. He rejects their mouth service of hypocrisy.

✧ His silence at their wickedness gives them arrogance not knowing that their day of Judgment is coming.

The Lord is not slack concerning *His* promise, as some count slackness, but is longsuffering toward us, \* not willing that any should perish but that all should come to repentance. [2 Peter 3:9, Romans 2:1-4, 9:22-24]

✧ "Now consider this, you who forget Elowah (God), Lest I tear *you* in pieces, And *there be* none to deliver:

Whoever offers praise glorifies Me; And to him who orders *his* conduct *aright* I will show the salvation of Elohiym (God)." [Psalm 50:22-23]

✧ The message is a warning to the wicked.

✧ The promise of Salvation for the righteous is a call for the wicked to repent.
