

## Psalm 62:1-12 MY SOUL, WAIT ON ELOHIYM

### *A Calm Resolve to Wait for the Salvation of God*

To the Chief Musician. To Jeduthun. A Psalm of David.

<sup>1</sup> Truly my soul silently *waits* for Elohiym (God); From Him *comes* my salvation.

<sup>2</sup> He only *is* my rock and my salvation; *He is* my defense; I shall not be greatly moved.

<sup>3</sup> How long will you attack a man? You shall be slain, all of you, Like a leaning wall and a tottering fence.

<sup>4</sup> They only consult to cast *him* down from his high position; They delight in lies; They bless with their mouth, But they curse inwardly.

<sup>5</sup> My soul, wait silently for Elohiym (God) alone, For my expectation *is* from Him.

<sup>6</sup> He only *is* my rock and my salvation; *He is* my defense; I shall not be moved.

<sup>7</sup> In Elohiym (God) *is* my salvation and my glory; The rock of my strength, *And* my refuge, *is* in Elohiym (God).

<sup>8</sup> Trust in Him at all times, you people; Pour out your heart before Him; Elohiym (God) *is* a refuge for us.

<sup>9</sup> Surely men of low degree *are* a vapor, Men of high degree *are* a lie; If they are weighed on the scales, They *are* altogether *lighter* than vapor.

<sup>10</sup> Do not trust in oppression, Nor vainly hope in robbery; If riches increase, Do not set *your heart on them*.

<sup>11</sup> Elohiym (God) has spoken once, Twice I have heard this: That power *belongs* to Elohiym (God).

<sup>12</sup> Also to You, O Adonay (Lord), *belongs* mercy; For You render to each one according to his work.

Facts Revealed:

✧ Truly my soul silently *waits* for Elohiym (God); From Him *comes* my salvation.

✧ Expressing confidence in Elohiym as his only reliable defense, David gives good advise to his soul which advise is appropriately applicable today.

✧ How long will you attack a man? You shall be slain, all of you, Like a leaning wall and a tottering fence.

✧ David described the behavior of his adversaries and asked, “How long?”

- ✧ David also spoke the expectancy of the wicked.
- ✧ My soul, wait silently for Elohiym (God) alone, For my expectation *is* from Him. He only *is* my rock and my salvation; *He is* my defense; I shall not be moved. In Elohiym (God) *is* my salvation and my glory; The rock of my strength, *And* my refuge, *is* in Elohiym (God). Trust in Him at all times, you people; Pour out your heart before Him; Elohiym (God) *is* a refuge for us. [[Psalm 62:5-8](#)]
- ✧ David described his faith in Elohiym.
- ✧ Then he advised all people to pray and trust in Elohiym at all times.
- ✧ Surely men of low degree *are* a vapor, Men of high degree *are* a lie; If they are weighed on the scales, They *are* altogether *lighter* than vapor. Do not trust in oppression, Nor vainly hope in robbery; If riches increase, Do not set *your heart on them*. [[Psalm 62:9-10](#)]
- ✧ Acknowledgment that mortality is extremely temporary.
- ✧ David, like Messiah Jesus, warned the wicked against pursuing unrighteous riches. [[Matthew 6:24](#), [Luke 16:13](#)]
- ✧ Elohiym (God) has spoken once, Twice I have heard this: That power *belongs* to Elohiym (God). Also to You, O Adonay (Lord), *belongs* mercy; For You render to each one according to his work. [[Psalm 62:11-12](#)]
- ✧ David recognized that to Elohiym is all power through Adonay for rendering merciful justice to each one according to his behavior.
