Psalm 9:1-20 Yahweh the Righteous Judge – Praise Yahweh's Righteousness

Prayer and Thanksgiving for the Lord's Righteous Judgments

To the Chief Musician. To the tune of "Death of the Son." A Psalm of David.

- I will praise You, O Yahweh (Lord), with my whole heart; I will tell of all Your marvelous works.
- 2 I will be glad and rejoice in You; I will sing praise to Your name, O Elyown (Most High).

David described the righteous Judgment of Yahweh

- 3 When my enemies turn back, They shall fall and perish at Your presence.
- 4 For You have maintained my right and my cause; You sat on the throne judging in righteousness.
- ⁵ You have rebuked the nations, You have destroyed the wicked; You have blotted out their name forever and ever.
- 6 O enemy, destructions are finished forever! And you have destroyed cities; Even their memory has perished.
- ⁷ But Yahweh (the Lord) shall endure forever; He has prepared His throne for judgment.
- 8 He shall judge the world in righteousness, And He shall administer judgment for the peoples in uprightness.
- 9 Yahweh (The Lord) also will be a refuge for the oppressed, A refuge in times of trouble.
- 10 And those who know Your name will put their trust in You; For You, Yahweh (Lord), have not forsaken those who seek You.
- 11 Sing praises to Yahweh (the Lord), who dwells in Zion! Declare His deeds among the people.
- 12 When He avenges blood, He remembers them; He does not forget the cry of the humble.
- 13 Have mercy on me, O Yahweh (Lord)! Consider my trouble from those who hate me, You who lift me up from the gates of death,
- 14 That I may tell of all Your praise In the gates of the daughter of Zion. I will rejoice in Your salvation.
- 15 The nations have sunk down in the pit which they made; In the net which they hid, their own foot is caught.
- 16 Yahweh (The Lord) is known by the judgment He executes; The wicked is snared in the work of his own hands.

Meditation, Selah

- 17 The wicked shall be turned into hell, And all the nations that forget Elohiym (God).
- 18 For the needy shall not always be forgotten; The expectation of the poor shall not perish forever.

Prayer concerning the nations

- 19 Arise, O Yahweh (Lord), Do not let man prevail; Let the nations be judged in Your sight.
- 20 Put them in fear, O Yahweh (Lord), That the nations may know themselves to be but men. NKJV

Facts Revealed:

Prayer and Thanksgiving for the Lord's Righteous Judgments

I will be glad and rejoice in You; I will sing praise to Your name, O Elyown (Most High). [Psalm 9:1-2]

- ♦ David promised to praise Yahweh with his whole heart and tell of His marvelous works.
- ♦ David will be glad and rejoice in Yahweh, singing praises to the name of Elyown.

David described the righteous Judgment of Yahweh [Psalm 9:3-18]

- ♦ Yahweh will maintain the cause of the righteous.
- ♦ Yahweh will rebuke the nations, destroy the wicked, and blot out their names forever.
- ♦ Yahweh will endure forever, His throne is prepared for Judgment.
- ♦ Yahweh is a refuge for the oppressed in times of trouble.
- ♦ Those who know Yahweh put their trust in Him.
- ♦ Yahweh has not forsaken those who seek Him.
- ❖ David called for the righteous to sing praises to Yahweh and declare His deeds among the people.
- ♦ Yahweh revenges the blood of the righteous and does not forget the cry of the humble.
- ❖ David called on Yahweh, who lifts him up from the gates of death, to consider the trouble from those who hate him. That he may publicly tell of all the praise to Yahweh and rejoice in His salvation.
- ❖ The nations have sunk down to the pit, caught their feet in their own net, and are snared in the work of their own hands.
- → Yahweh is known by the judgment He executes.

Selah (pause to meditate on this).

- ♦ The wicked and all the nations that forget Elohiym shall be turned to hell.
- ♦ The needy shall not be forgotten. The poor shall not perish forever.

Prayer concerning the nations

- ☆ Arise, O Yahweh (Lord), Do not let man prevail; Let the nations be judged in Your sight.

 Put them in fear, O Yahweh (Lord), That the nations may know themselves to be but men.

 [Psalm 9:19-20]
 - → Prayer that the nations be humbled before Yahweh.
