#### Facts Revealed:

Chosen for Salvation – Called by our Gospel [2 Thessalonians 2:13-14]

- Paul abounds in thanksgiving to God for the Thessalonians. He recognizes that they are beloved by the Lord.
  - ❖ From the very beginning, God chose them for Salvation.
  - ♦ They were sanctified (set apart for God) by the Holy Spirit and belief in the truth.
  - ♦ They were called by our Gospel for obtaining the glory of our Lord Jesus Christ.

## Hold fast to original Gospel Message [2 Thessalonians 2:15]

- There is always a present danger from false doctrine that forces believers to exercise discernment lest they be led astray by the error of deceivers. [2 Peter 3:17, Hebrews 2:1-4, 2 Timothy 4:3-4, Colossians 1:21-23, 2:8]
  - ♦ The required choice of the believer is to hold fast to the doctrine originally delivered by the Apostles.
