

Psalm 114:1-8 **Israel the Dominion of Elowah – Judah His Sanctuary**

*The Power of God in His Deliverance of Israel*

(cf. Exodus 14)

<sup>1</sup> When Israel went out of Egypt, The house of Jacob from a people of strange language,  
<sup>2</sup> Judah became His sanctuary, *And* Israel His dominion.

<sup>3</sup> The sea saw *it* and fled; Jordan turned back.

<sup>4</sup> The mountains skipped like rams, The little hills like lambs.

<sup>5</sup> What ails you, O sea, that you fled? O Jordan, *that* you turned back?

<sup>6</sup> O mountains, *that* you skipped like rams? O little hills, like lambs?

<sup>7</sup> Tremble, O earth, at the presence of Adown (the Lord), At the presence of Elowah (the God of) Jacob,

<sup>8</sup> Who turned the rock *into* a pool of water, The flint into a fountain of waters.
