Facts Revealed:

- ✧ Elohiym (God) *is* our refuge and strength, A very present help in trouble. - ✧ Whatever comes, we will still trust in Elohiym as our refuge.
- ✧ *There is* a river whose streams shall make glad the city of Elohiym (God), The holy *place* of the tabernacle of the Most High. Elohiym (God) *is* in the midst of her, she shall not be moved; Elohiym (God) shall help her, just at the break of dawn. [Psalm 46:4-5]

- ✧ The sons of Korah knew prophetically of the river of healing from the temple during the Kingdom Age which portrays the River of Life in New Jerusalem. [Ezekiel 47:1-9, Revelation 22:1-5]
- ✧ The nations raged, the kingdoms were moved; He uttered His voice, the earth melted.
Yahweh Tsebaaovt (The LORD of hosts) *is* with us; Elohey (The God of) Jacob *is* our refuge. [Psalm 46:6-7]
- ✧ The rage of nations cannot stand up to the power of Yahweh Tsebaaovt. [Micah 7:16-20, Zechariah 14:9, Daniel 7:13-14]
- ✧ Come, behold the works of Yahweh (the LORD), Who has made desolations in the earth.
He makes wars cease to the end of the earth; He breaks the bow and cuts the spear in two; He burns the chariot in the fire. [Psalm 46:8-9]
- ✧ During the Kingdom Age, there will be universal peace. [Isaiah 2:4, 11:6-9, 16:18-25, Hosea 2:18]
- ✧ Be still, and know that I *am* Elohiym (God); I will be exalted among the nations, I will be exalted in the earth!
Yahweh Tsebaaovt (The LORD of hosts) *is* with us; Elohey (The God of) Jacob *is* our refuge. [Psalm 46:10-11]
- ✧ During the Kingdom Age, Elohiym will be exalted as He in the person of Jesus will be King of kings and Lord of lords.
- ✧ All the nations of the earth will come to Jerusalem to worship Him. [Isaiah 2:1-5, 11:10, 52:10, 60:3, Micah 4:1-8]
